



# Wireless Headphone Case User Manual




## 一、 Overview



1, TYPE-C Power plug 2. Earphone compartment 3. Earphone charging indicator light 4. Headphone charging contact 5. headset 6. Multi functional touch keys for headphones

## 二、 bluetooth



**1、Remove the headphones** sound “power on”, The indicator light remains blue for 1 second; Automatically team up after startup, Entering reconnection/pairing state; 5 minutes of incomplete reconnection/pairing, automatic shutdown. 2. Long press the earphone function button for 2 seconds. 3. sound “pairing” (Disconnect and enter pairing without this prompt sound), The red and blue indicator lights of the main ear flash alternately, Auxiliary ear blue light flashing slowly, After successful reconnection/pairing, sound “connected”, The blue indicator light on the main ear flashes for 5 seconds before turning off.

### 三. LED indicator status

Quick flashing indicator light	The indicator light turns on for 0.2 seconds and goes off for 0.2 seconds, which is a cycle
Indicator light flashing slowly	The indicator light turns on for 0.2 seconds and goes off for 2 seconds, which is a cycle
Flashing indicator light	The indicator light is on for 0.5 seconds and off for 0.5 seconds, which is a cycle
Indicator light breathing flashing	The indicator light gradually turns from light to dark for 1 second, and then turns from dark to light for 1 second in a cycle
Red and blue indicator lights alternate and flash quickly	The red indicator light is on for 0.2 seconds, and the blue indicator light is on for 0.2 seconds, which is a cycle
The red and blue indicator lights alternate and flash slowly	The red indicator light is on for 0.5 seconds, and the blue indicator light is on for 0.5 seconds, which is a cycle

horse race lamp	The indicator lights light up sequentially from the first one and then turn off (the first light stays on and on) in a cycle
pilot lamp	Indicator light always on

#### 四. Instructions for using headphones

1. Headphone power on: The earphones will automatically turn on when they are out of the compartment. Press and hold for 2 seconds to turn on the earphones
2. Headphone shutdown: If the phone is not connected, press and hold for 5 seconds to turn it off; 5 minutes of shutdown without connection; Warehouse shutdown
3. Click: Three party call status; Hang up the current call and switch to the other suspended party's call
4. Double click: Play pause music, answer calls, hang up calls, hang up calls.
5. Three strikes: L for the previous song, R for the next song. Turn on and off SIRI in no audio state. Requires support from the phone itself.
6. Long press: When playing music; L reduces the volume; R increases the volume; Single earphones do not have this function

#### 五. Specification parameters

1. Headphone capacity battery 3.7V/2 \* 25mAh
2. Bluetooth effective distance unobstructed 10m

#### 六. Restore factory settings

1. Please delete the phone pairing first. When the earphones are not connected to the device, tap the left and right ears 5 times at the same time. The traffic lights will flash quickly and then turn off. After the "DU" sound, the prompt "power off, clear pairing for both ears" will appear. Then, place the earphones in the charging compartment and close the cover before removing and pairing again.

#### 七. Precautions

2. Do not use corrosive cleaning agents to clean this product
3. Do not allow this product to be heated or placed near a source of fire

4.Do not expose this product to long-term sunlight exposure  
4.Do not disassemble or modify this product without authorization

5.Do not use this product in the rain

6.If this product is not used for a long time, please store it in a dry place and keep it charged once a month to extend its service life
