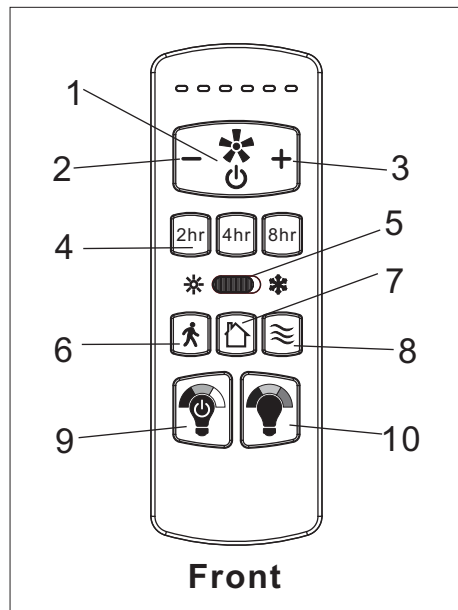
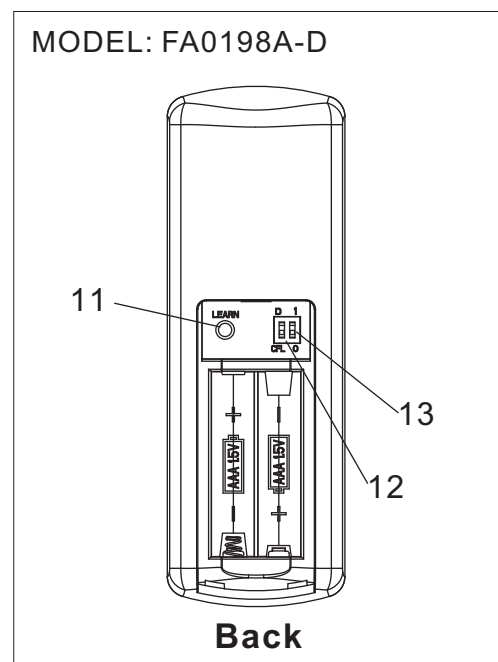
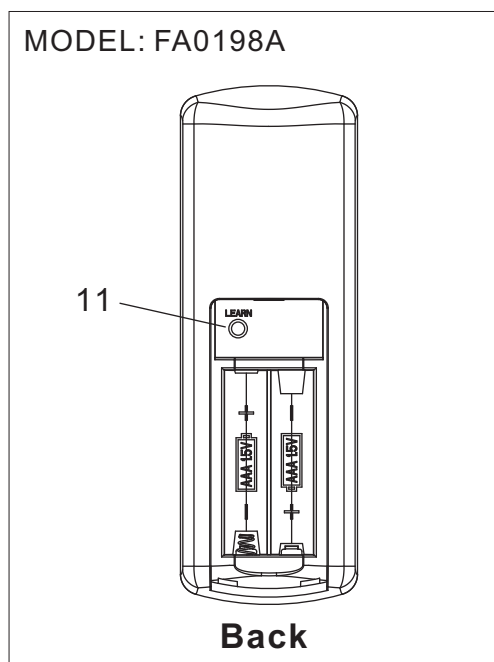

## **Remote Control Functions:**

1. FAN ON/OFF Button: Turn the fan on or off.
2. FAN Speed Button “-”: Decreases the fan speed.
3. FAN Speed Button “+”: Increases the fan speed.
4. 2hr/ 4hr/ 8hr Timer button.
5. Reverse Setting Switch: To control fan direction.
6. Walk Away Delay Off Button.
7. Home Shield Button.
8. Nature Breeze Button.
9. LIGHT ON/OFF/DIMMING Button: To control light on/off/dimming.
10. CCT Function Button.
11. Extended Function Switch L.

# OPERATION INSTRUCTION
