Question #1: Page 5 of user manual states: "

FCC RF Radiation Exposure Statement:

1. This Transmitter has been demonstrated co-location compliance requirements with Bluetooth / Model no. AN2 BLUETOOTH. This transmitter must not be co-located or operating in conjunction with any other antenna or transmitter.

2. This equipment complies with FCC RF radiation exposure limits set forth for an uncontrolled environment. This device was tested for typical lap held operations with the device contacted directly to the human body to the back side of the BLUETOOTH INTEGRATED VGA MONITOR. To maintain compliance with FCC RF exposure compliance requirements, avoid direct contact to the transmitting antenna during transmitting."

Based upon above statement, looks like there are multiple transmitters. What is the FCC ID number of Model No:AN2 Bluetooth ?

Above statement claims that this device has been tested for SAR compliance. Please explain this statement. There is no SAR test report submitted in this application.
