I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

1. Please note that it is not fully understood what this application is. It appears from some of the exhibits that you seek modular or Limited Modular approval for the BT. If this is an application for modular or Limited Modular Approval of the BT transmitter, please provide the required exhibit explaining how the device meets the 8 modular requirements of DA001407. Otherwise, please explain more fully what type certification is to apply to this device.
2. Please note that page 3 of the test report shows an antenna gain value of  $>0\text{dBi}$ . (Max). This is confusing as the antenna spec shows  $1.5\text{dBi}$  gain and this tends to show the antenna gain limit of the device to be  $0\text{dBi}$ . Please confirm or explain if the intent of the statement is to make  $0\text{dBi}$  the maximum antenna gain, or if the intent is to make  $1.5\text{dBi}$  the maximum antenna gain as indicated in the report and antenna spec.
3. Please note that page 10 of the data portion of the report states that the antenna cable loss was provided by the client. Please note that losses used in direct relation to a measurement cannot be assumed and must have supporting evidence. Please either measure the conducted power directly at the antenna connection (i.e. after the cable) or please provide the calibration factors from the manufacturer on the cable used to support the data.
4. Please note that the FCC ID label appears to be a simple paper printed label. Please note that if this is true it is not allowed by the FCC. Please provide an explanation of what the label is made of and how it is permanently affixed to the device as required by 2.925(d).
