

# IV. Maintenance and Troubleshooting

#### How to Use Screen Correctly

#### Application Notes



- Don't keep in high temperature for long time.
- Please keep direct sunlight away from the screen when it is not used.
- Please use the screen in the temperature range:
   Operating temperature: -20~+70
   Storage temperature: -40~+85C
- Please don't use sharp objects. Please be sure to click the screen by hand or else it may bring scratches to the screen.

## Screen Picture

- There may be small black dot or flashing point (bright spot) on screen. This is the special phenomenon of screen, but not fault.
- If bright light shines directly at screen, screen will be vague for light reflection.

# Maintenance

- Before cleaning dust or stain on screen, please shut off power first and then wipe screen by soft cloth.
- Please be careful to avoid screen scratched by nail when wiping screen, or else, it will be hard to get clear image.
- Please do not use wet cloth, versatile oil or thinner to wipe screen.

# Notes for Disc Operation

• Do not use disc with crack and stain or bended



• Do not use irregular (non circular) disc to avoid any fault.



Only 12cm disc to be inserted.

 Do not touch burned surface (the surface with colorful gloss) when operating disc. Do not damage disc.

Do not paste paper or tag on disc.



Tips

In consideration of product design, if there is any scratch / fault on surface of disc, this is not product fault.

#### Maintenance

 If disc is attached with dust, please wipe it by clean soft cloth inside out. Do not use oil or thinner. In addition, do not use antistatic agent.



## Notes for Storage



- Do not store in direct sunlight or high temperature.
- Please be sure to place into disc box to Avoid bending.

# Environment to Play Disc

- During vehicle driving, it may be impossible to read disc data correctly due to vibration.
  If disc is played immediately after radiator is
- If disc is played immediately after radiator is started at low temperature, it may be impossible to play disc as normal due to lens or disc condensation (condensation effect). And now, please wait for about 1 hour until dew evaporated and then wipe disc with soft cloth.
- When the product temperature rises, protection effect will be functional and some functions will stop.
