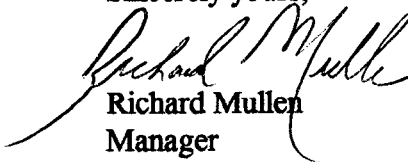

The subject device is a 17" Color Monitor with digital controlled auto-scan that supports 30-95 kHz horizontal, 50-160 Hz vertical sync frequencies with maximum resolution up to 1600x1200, Non-Interlaced. This monitor is provided with such features as: (1) 15-Pin D-Sub, 5xBNC and USB Port interface connectors; (2) detachable shielded 15-Pin D-Sub connector signal cable with two bonded ferrite cores, 5xBNC shielded signal cable with one bonded ferrite core, and shielded USB cable without any ferrite core; and (3) detachable non-shielded power supply cord.

This EUT was system tested in accordance with C63.4-1992 to show compliance to FCC Part 15 limits. Compliance tests were performed in representative worst-case video modes 1280x1024 @ 91.1 kHz and 93.7 kHz with 15-Pin D-Sub connector and USB port connected to host computer and again at 1600x1200 @ 93.7 kHz with BNC connector and USB port connected to host computer.
