Question #1: This is a Class II permissive change filing. In the cover letter, it says "Adding another shape KAE antenna". But the SAR report does not mention this, it shows test data with two antennas: KAE, and Foxconn which was already covered in the original filing. Please explain why the device with Foxconn antenna needs to be retested, what kind of change(s) have been made.

<answer> There are no changes to the Foxconn antenna. However, a preliminary test was made to determine which antenna (KAE or Foxconn) produces the highest SAR. In the original test, an preliminary test was used to determine which antenna (KAE or Foxconn) produces worse SAR.
