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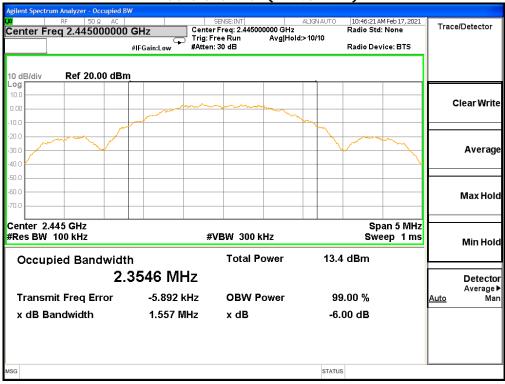

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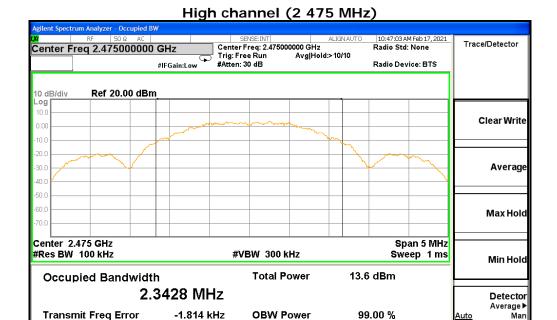

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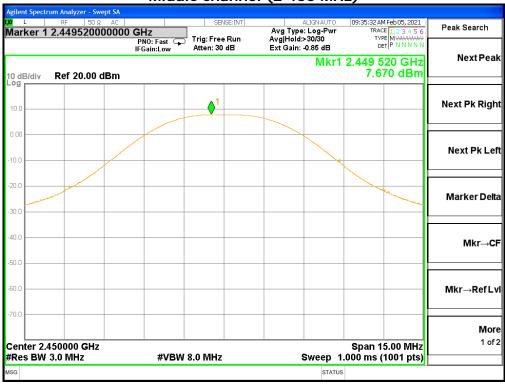

The Unwanted emission from the EUT were measured according to the dictates PKPSD measurement procedure in section 11.11 of ANSI C63.10-2013.

In any 100 kHz bandwidth outside the frequency band in which the spread spectrum or digitally modulated device is operating, the RF power that is produced shall be at least 20 dB below that in the 100 kHz bandwidth within the band that contains the highest level of the desired power, based on either an RF conducted or a radiated measurement, provided that the transmitter demonstrates compliance with the peak conducted power limits. For field strength of emissions from 30 MHz to 1 GHz



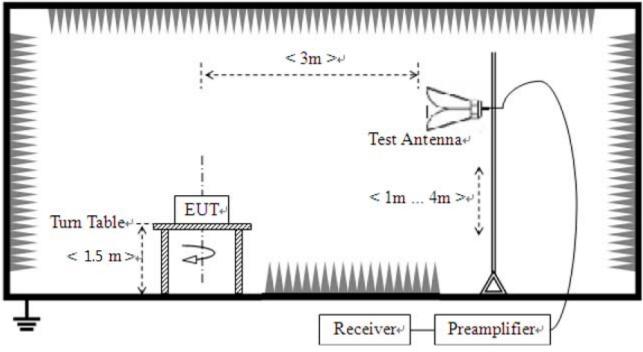
