I am currently reviewing an application for a portable tablet pc that incorporates an NII transmitter. In order to demonstrate compliance with the requirement of Section 15.407(e), the applicant proposes using the following language in their user's manual. Please advise if this is sufficient to demonstrate compliance with the requirement.

Proposed language: **This device is capable of operating in Wi-Fi mode in the 2.4 and 5 GHz bands. The FCC requires that devices operating within 5.15-5.25 GHz may only be used indoors, not outside, in order to avoid interference with Mobile Satellite Services (MSS). Therefore, do not use this device outside as a Wi-Fi hotspot or in Wi-Fi Direct mode outside when using the 5.15-5.25 GHz band.**

FCC response on 01/15/2013

This is acceptable due to precedents although the preferred approach is to disable those features when operating in the 5150-5250 MHz band because typical users are not aware of the channel being used. If the conducted power is close to 15.407(a) limit and/or antenna gain is high, we may ask the applicant for more protective measures.
