Getting Started

1. Install a memory card in the DashCam:


- 1 On the right side of the dash cam: pull back the cover that protects the card slot.
- 2 Slide the card into the slot until it clicks into place.
- 3 Replace the cover.




Getting Started

2. Attach the suction cup mount to a window and connect the DashCam:

- 1 Press the suction cup against the windshield.
- 2 Rotate the knob on the mount to lock it in place.
- 3 On the bottom of the GPS mount, press the two tabs inward, and hold them.








Getting Started

3. Connect the USB power cable to the suction cup mount:

Connect the USB cable to the knob on the mount. You can also connect the USB cable to the port on the camera.



4. Turn the DashCam on and off:


The DashCam powers on automatically when you connect it to a power source. You can also press and hold the Power button (located on the top right of the DashCam) to turn it on and off.

5. Pair the DashCam with your phone:

- Download and install the Rand McNally DashCam 500 app on your phone. This free app is available on the Canal Or Coogle Play .
- Turn on wifi® on the DashCam.
- 3 From the app on your phone, select the wifi® network shown on the DashCam.
- 4 Enter the wifi® password as shown on the DashCam. Your DashCam is now ready to use.

How Do I...

Install the DashCam app:

On an iOS device:

- 1. Open the App Store on your device.
- 2. Search for Rand McNally DashCam-500.
- 3. Select and install the app.

Enable Wi-Fi® on the DashCam:

Tap the Wi-Fi button () to enable or disable Wi-Fi.

The Wi-Fi screen opens, and you can view the network name to use to connect your phone.

Format a memory card for initial use:

From the DashCam:

- 1. Navigate to the **SETTINGS** screen.
- 2. Use the up and down arrows to highlight **Format SD Card.**
- Press
- 4. Select **Yes**.

On an Android Device:

- 1. Open the Google Play store on your device.
- 2. Search for Rand McNally DashCam-500.

Navigate through screens on the DashCam:

Use the dynamic buttons below the screen to navigate. Press one of the four buttons to select an option.

How Do I...

View videos on your phone:

- 1 Tap **VIDEOS** on the app.
- 2 Tap a video to begin playback.
- 3 Tap the play/pause button to control playback.
- Tap **Download, Share,** or **Delete** to manage the video.



Using the flashback feature:

Using the flashback feature allows you to tag and protect a video from being erased accidentally.

The flashback feature helps you preserve a scene or incident that may have just happened several seconds in the past, allowying you to quickly go back in time and save the videos.

Tap the flashback feature button at any time to tag a video. The pricon displays on flashback videos.



How Do I...

Transfer photos and videos to my phone:

- 1 Tap IMAGES or VIDEOS on the app.
- 2 Select a category.
- 3 Tap **Select,** and tap each video to transfer.
- 4 Tap **1** to download the selected files.
- 5 Tap **OK** to begin.









View the live camera feed on my phone:

- 6 Tap **LIVE FEED** on the app.
- 7 The live feed, with controls, displays on the app.

When you use the phone to view and control the live feed, the DashCam's functions are temporarily disabled.
