










# <Dipole Verification Data> - D2300 V2, serial no. 1006 (Data of Measurement : 01.16.2024) 2300 MHz - Head












# <Dipole Verification Data> - D2450V2, serial no. 736 (Data of Measurement : 08.15.2023) D2450V2 MHz - Head












