3. The EUT utilizes a (micro) USB port, and the User's Manual references connecting the EUT to a pc via USB for charging. Please note that the FCC has stated that, since USB charging typically includes some form of handshake between the device and the pc (i.e., data transfer), the presence of an unmodified USB port, even ostensibly for charging purposes only, makes the EUT a pc peripheral, subject to either Verification/SDOC (for a Class A digital device) or Certification/SDOC (for a Class B digital device). Please address.

Response: As can be seen from the schematics (page 1), the data lines on the micro USB are no-connect. Only power is supplied through this port. Therefore, it is not considered a PC peripheral.
