Re: FCC Part 15 Certification for Bose Corporation (FCC ID: A94-M1)

To whom it may concern;

In response to Correspondence Reference Number 5010 (FCC ID: A94-M1, 731 Confirmation Number EA92297), I am addressing the issues raised by Joe Dichoso.

Q1) You cannot file both transmitters under one FCC identifier. You need to file another application. Indicate whether you want the remote or the base unit under the pending application and file another application for the other. Another confidential fee will also probably need to be filed.

A1) We understand the requirement and are filing a second application for the Personal Music Center (remote). That application will be sent shortly. Please proceed with the current application (FCC ID: A94-M1, Confirmation Number EA92297) with the intent on certifying the Multi-Room Interface (base station).

Q2) In order to clarify exactly what you are requesting confidential, supply a signed confidential letter listing confidential items and number of pages of each item. I cannot find the component specifications. Is this the Bill of Material?

A2) We would like to request that the information on pages 107 (RDL diagram), pages 108,109 (schematics) and 112-115 (bill of materials) be held confidential.

Q3) The second harmonic on page 11 of the report shows an emission of 54 dBuV/m that is just over the limit of 500 uV/m or 53.98 dBuV/m. Please explain/correct.

A3) The emission in question relates to the Personal Music Center (remote). This issue will be resolved with the second application that is being filed for it. (see A1 above)
