

Digital Security Code

The Model CP-750 uses digital security coding to provide protection against unintentional access to the public switched telephone network by the base unit and unintentional ringing by the handset as specified in Section 15.214(d).

The Model CP-750 uses the following means and/or procedure to achieve the required protection.

The Model CP-750 automatically selects a different code from at least 256 possible discrete digital codes each time the handset is placed in the base.
