I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

- 1. FYI Please note that the FCC has in the last 12 months had objections to listing emissions designators for 2M25F9W, 3M73F9W etc. The positions is basically that these transmissions are only adjacent channels used in conjunction and as such would fall under the 1M25 designation. Please be aware that should the FCC require, these designators may have to be removed from the grant.
- Please note that the test report does not clearly identify the test methods used for spurious ERP measurements. Please note that TIA603 is the required method. While the results appear to be for this method, no statement to that affect has been made. Please explain if TIA603 was used, or if another method was used to make these measurements.
- 3. Please note that confidentiality has been requested for the internal photos. Howver, please also note that the manual has not been requested to be confidential and it contains photos and drawings of the internal mechanisms of the base station. If this information is considered confidential, you will also need to put the manual under the confidentiality request. Please advise.
