We request temporarily confidentiality of 45 days, starting from the original issued Certification grant date.

Panasonic also acknowledges that we will provide appropriate notice to UL Japan should either of the following occur.

- If we require additional 45 day extension period, we will notify UL Japan with a new request letter at least seven days prior to the short-term confidentiality expiration date [Note: up to a maximum of 3 extensions only allowed], or
- We will immediately notify UL Japan in the event the information regarding the product or the product is made available to the public. UL Japan will then release the documents listed above for public disclosure, pursuant to FCC Public Notice DA 04-1705.
