I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

1. FYI - please note that the non-modification statement on page 2 of the manual is confusing. The statement would be better stated, "Changes or modifications not expressly approved by Motorola could void the user's authority to operate the equipment."
2. It appears from the setup photos that the devices may not be the required 10cm separation as specified in ANSI C63.4 2003. When using the ANSI C63.4 setup please make sure that the separation is as required. Please show evidence of the correct separation distance between devices.
3. FYI – please note that you are still not correctly comparing your readings to the proper limits, When you use either a peak or QP reading to justify compliance and when the limit is average, then you must compare the peak or QP reading to the average limit. Consequently, while the device may be compliant, by not doing this, you are not reporting the correct margin for compliance. By not comparing the readings to the proper limits, the certification process takes longer as additional calculations and investigation of the actual limits arise.
4. Please note that the plot that is supposed to be on page 52 of the report is not there. Please explain.
