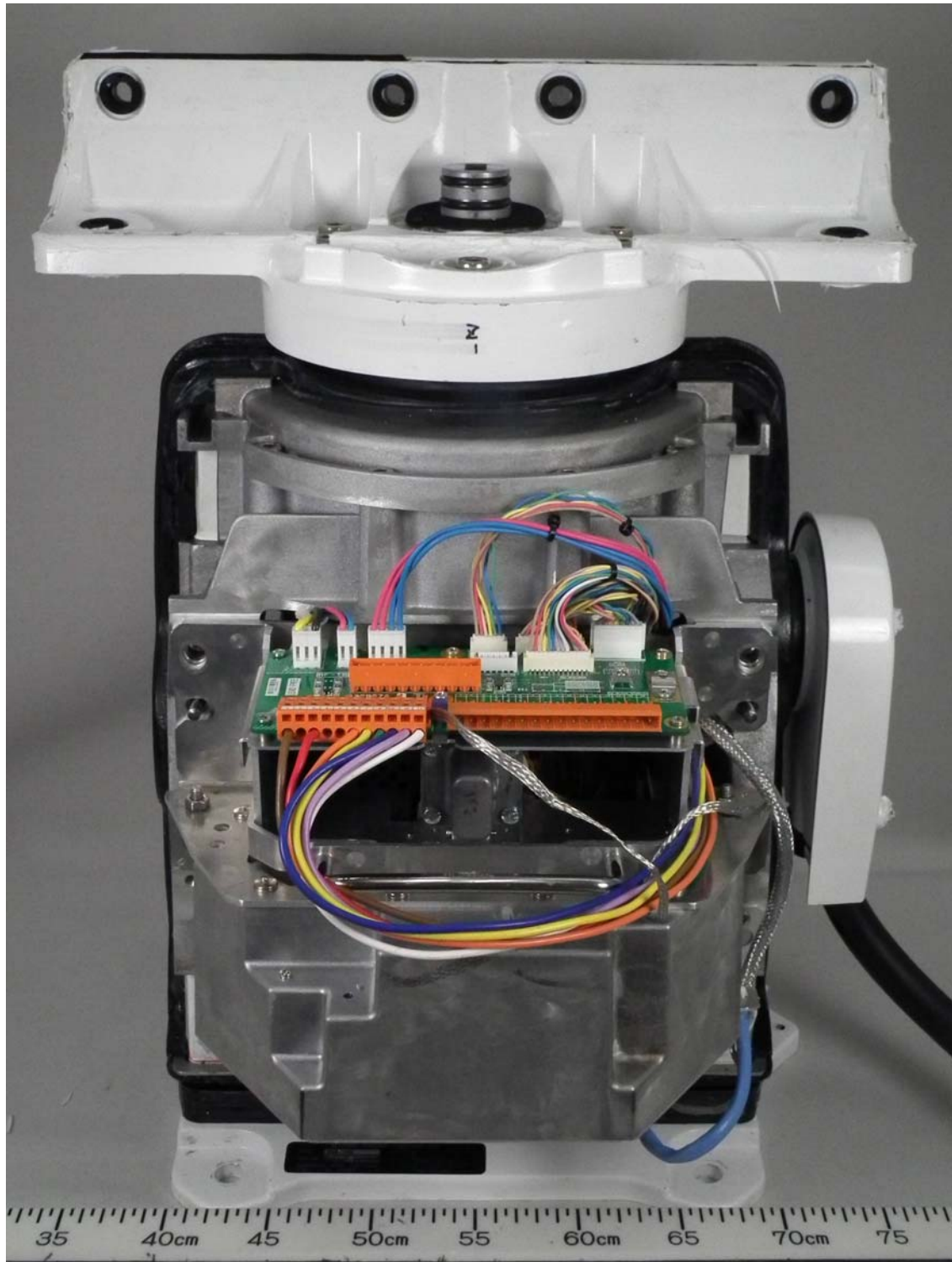

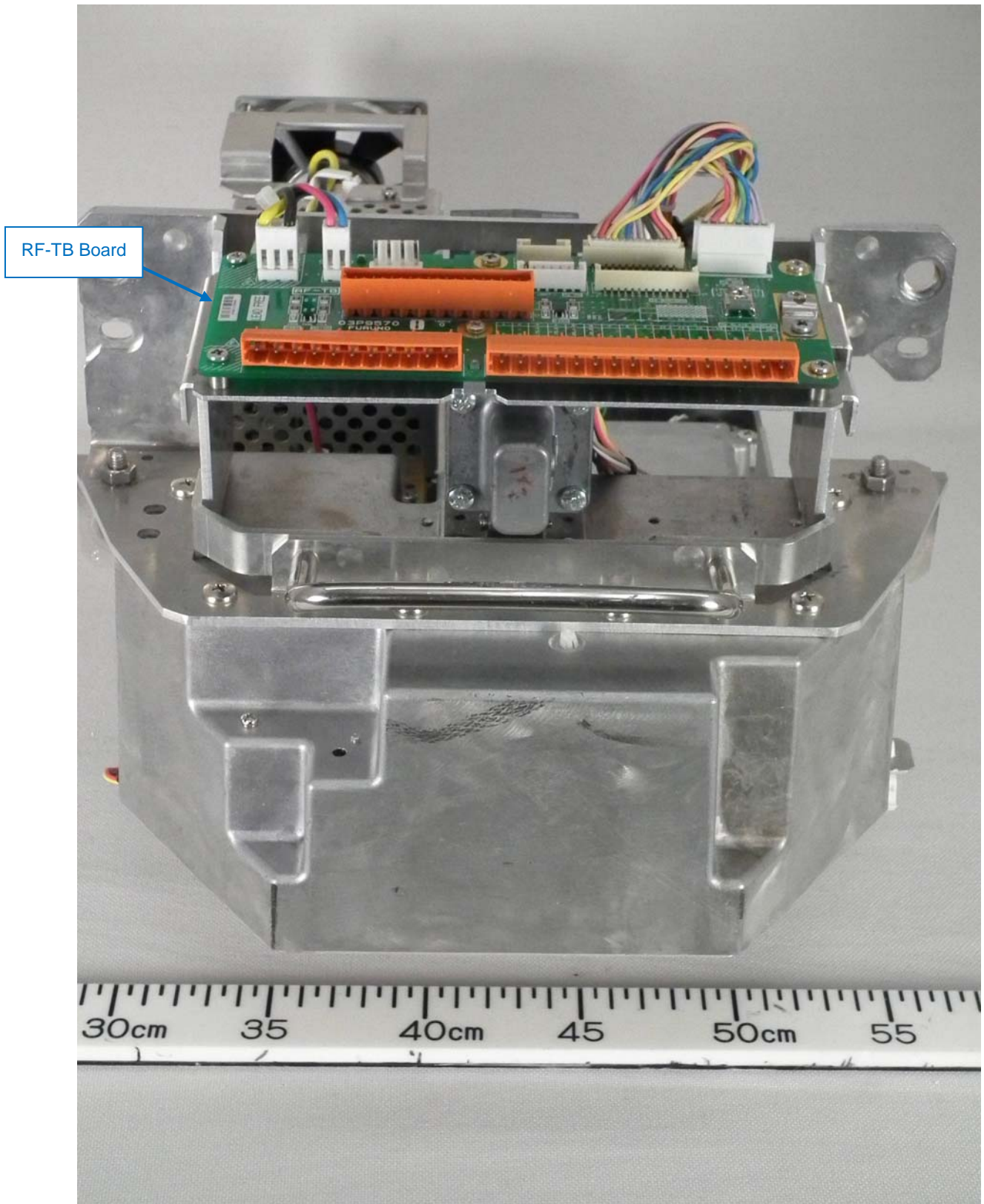
1 Transceiver RTR-106 (X-band, 25 kW)

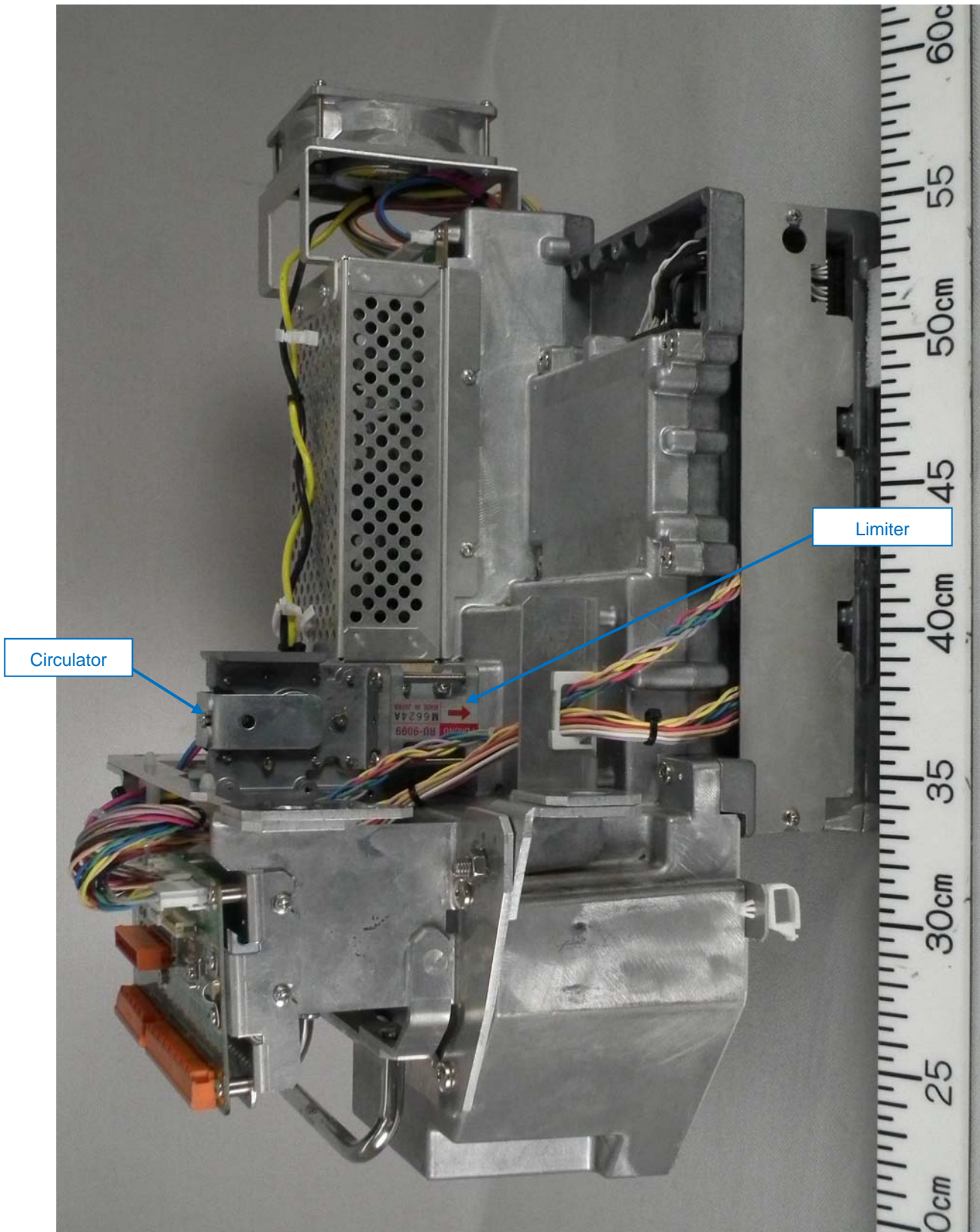
1.1.1 Rear View (with Transceiver contained in Gear Box RSB-128)



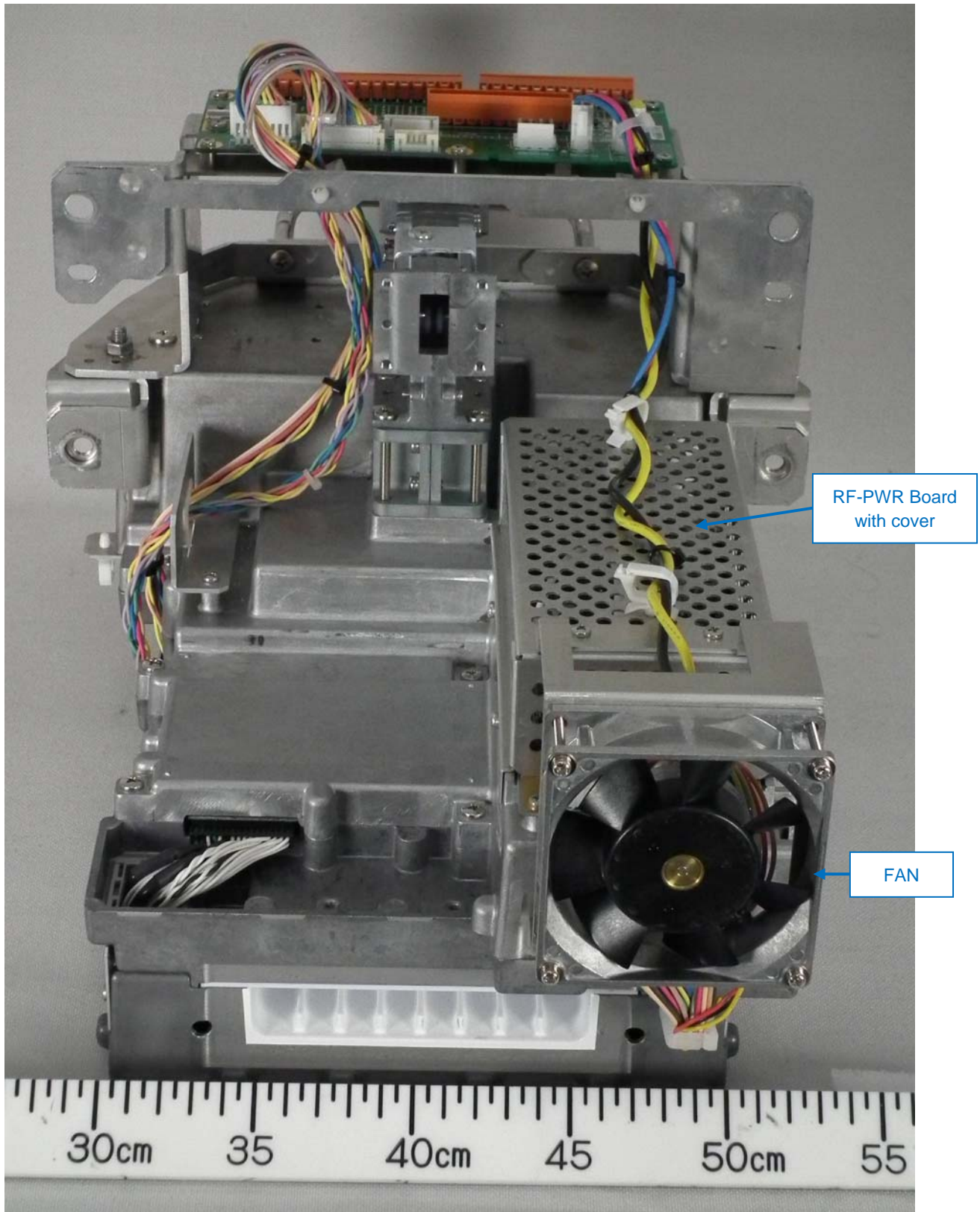
1.1.2 Front View (showing RF-TB Board 03P9570)



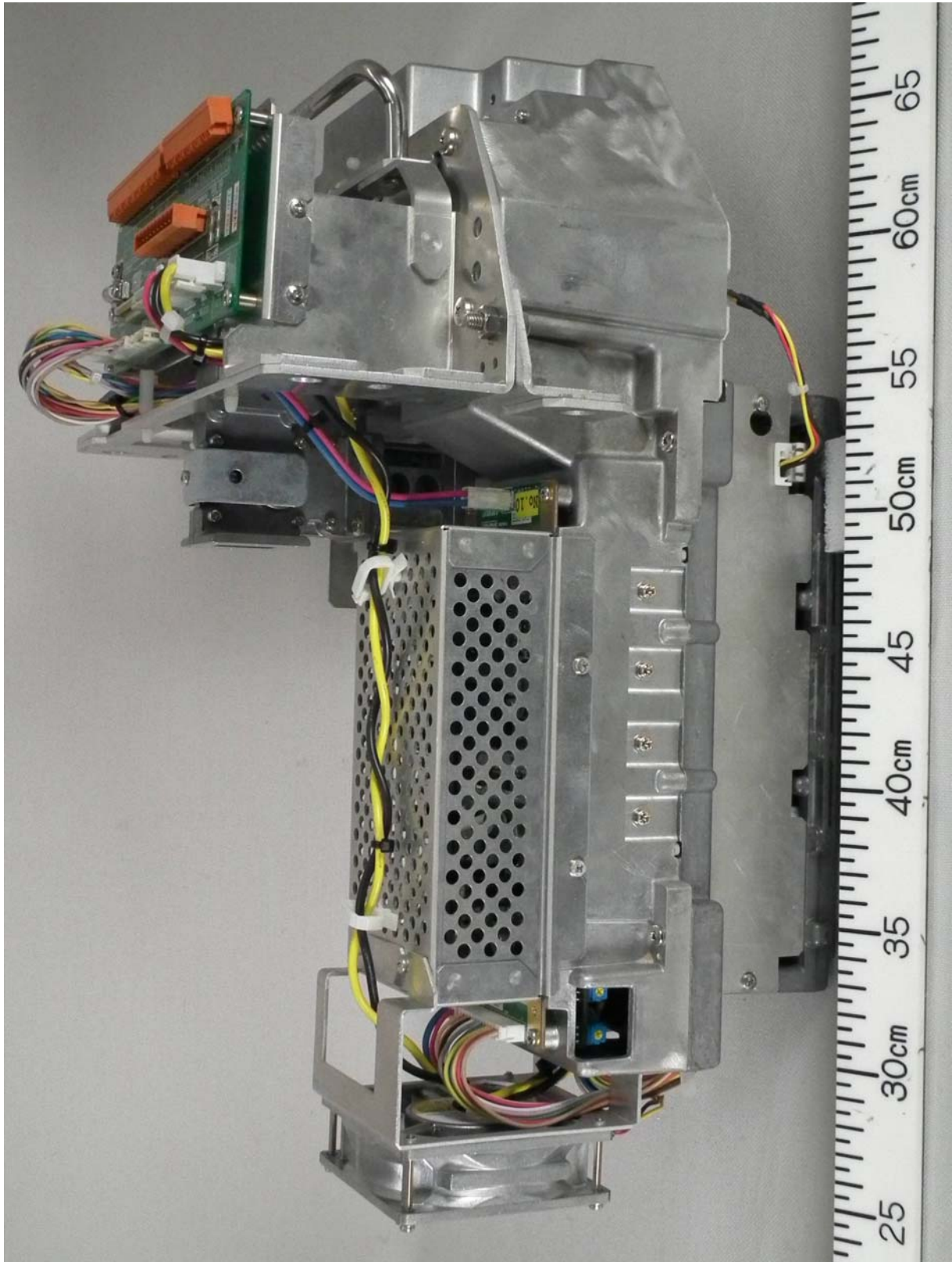

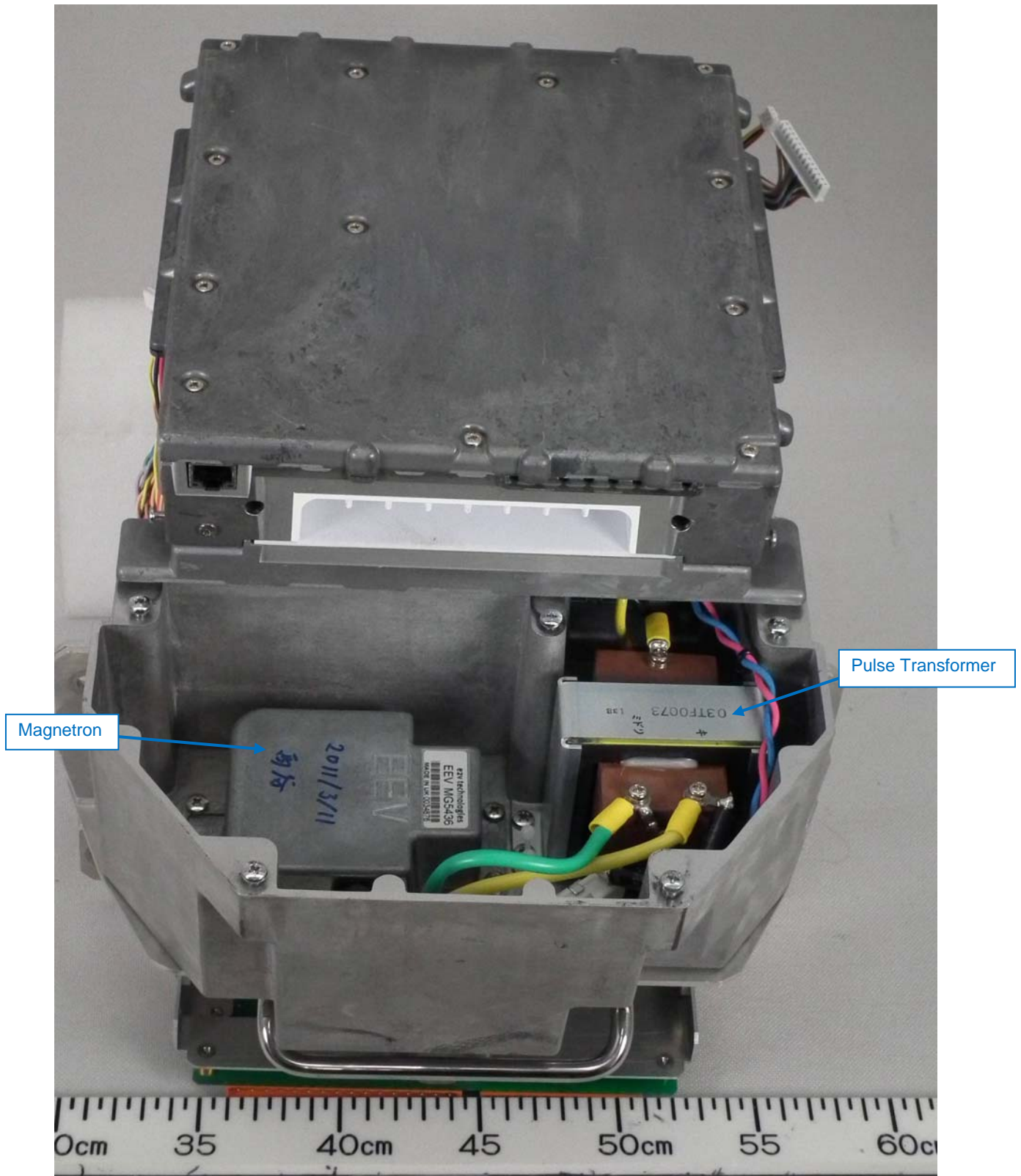

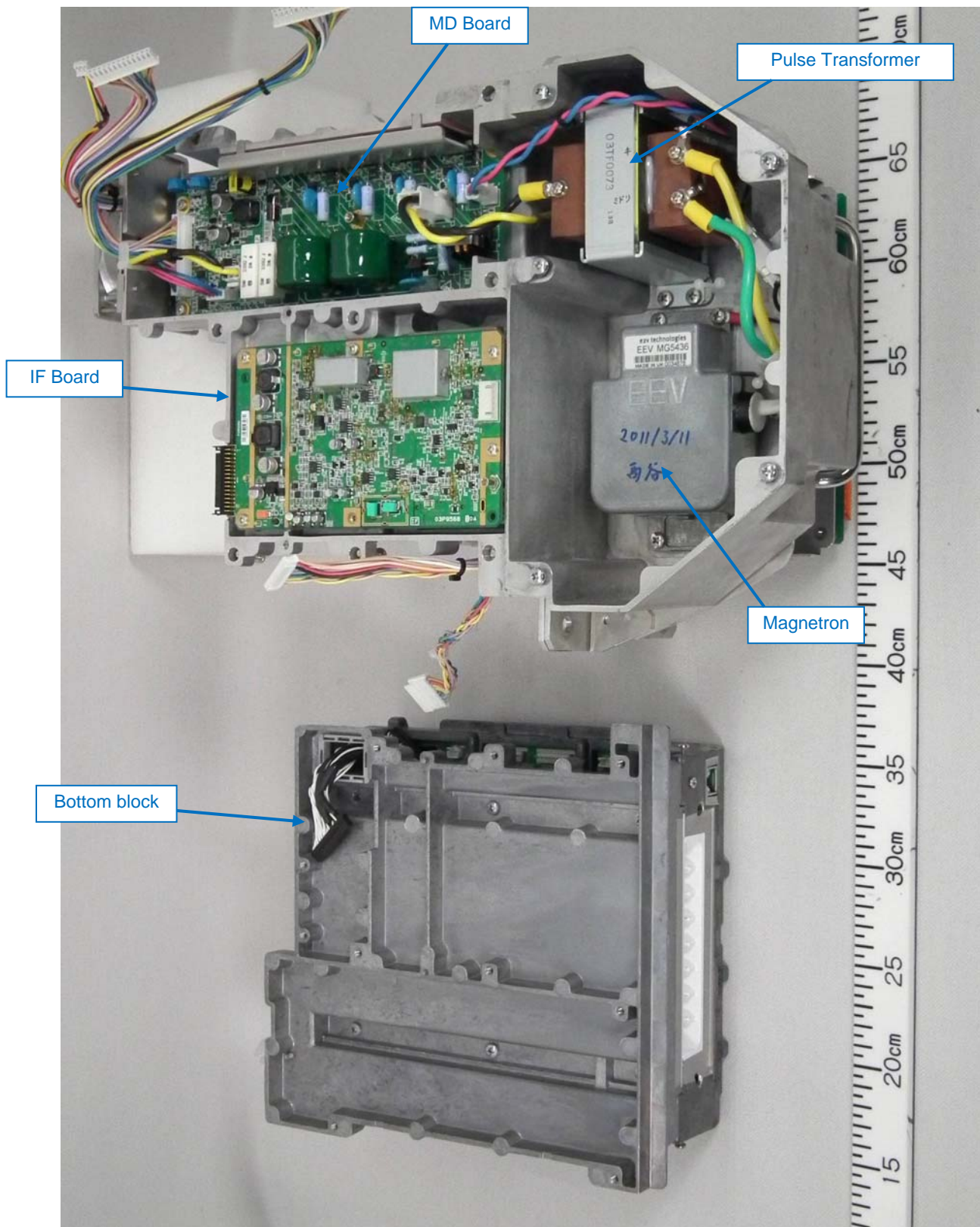

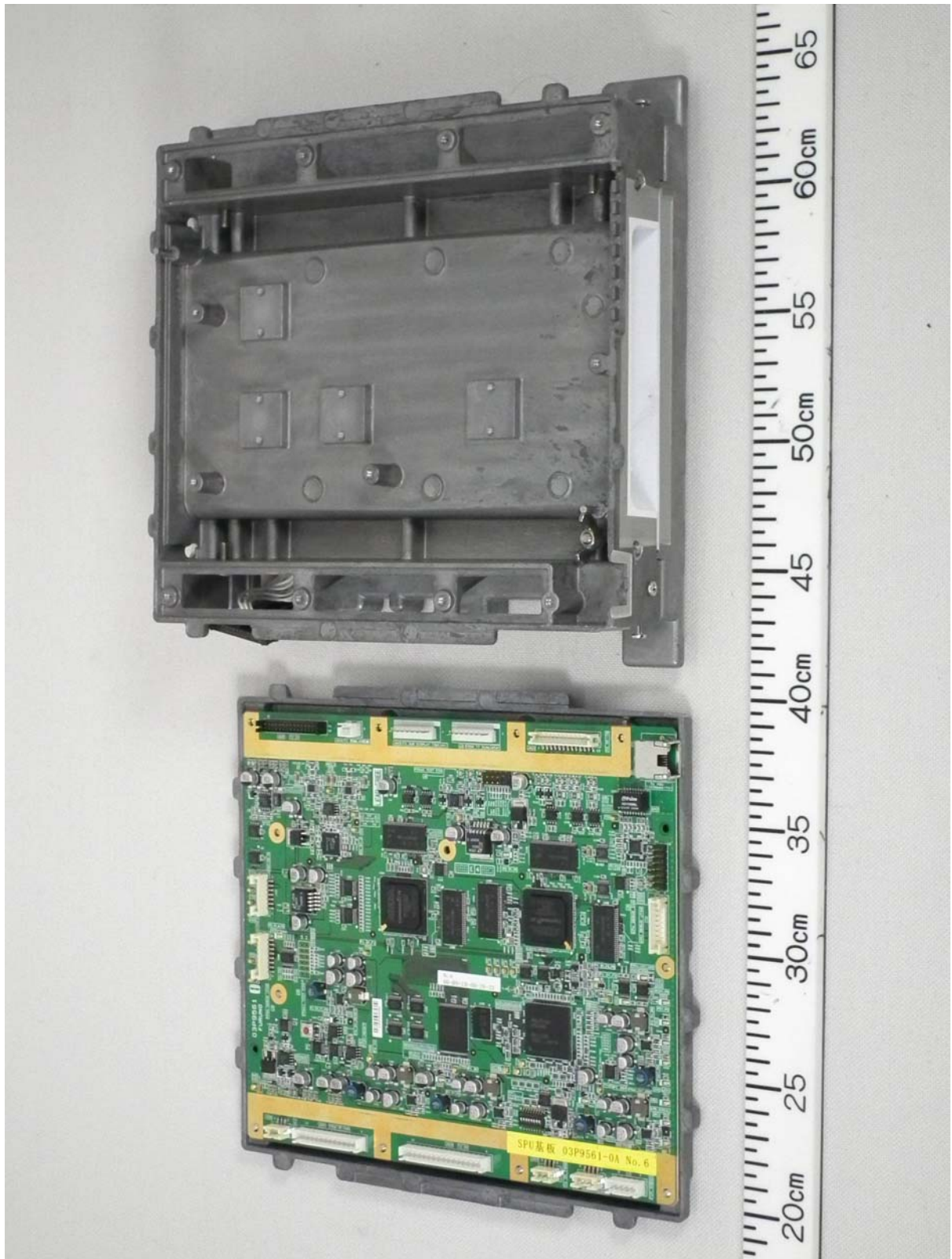
1.1.6 Bottom View (with Shield cover removed, showing Magnetron MG5436 and Pulse Transformer)



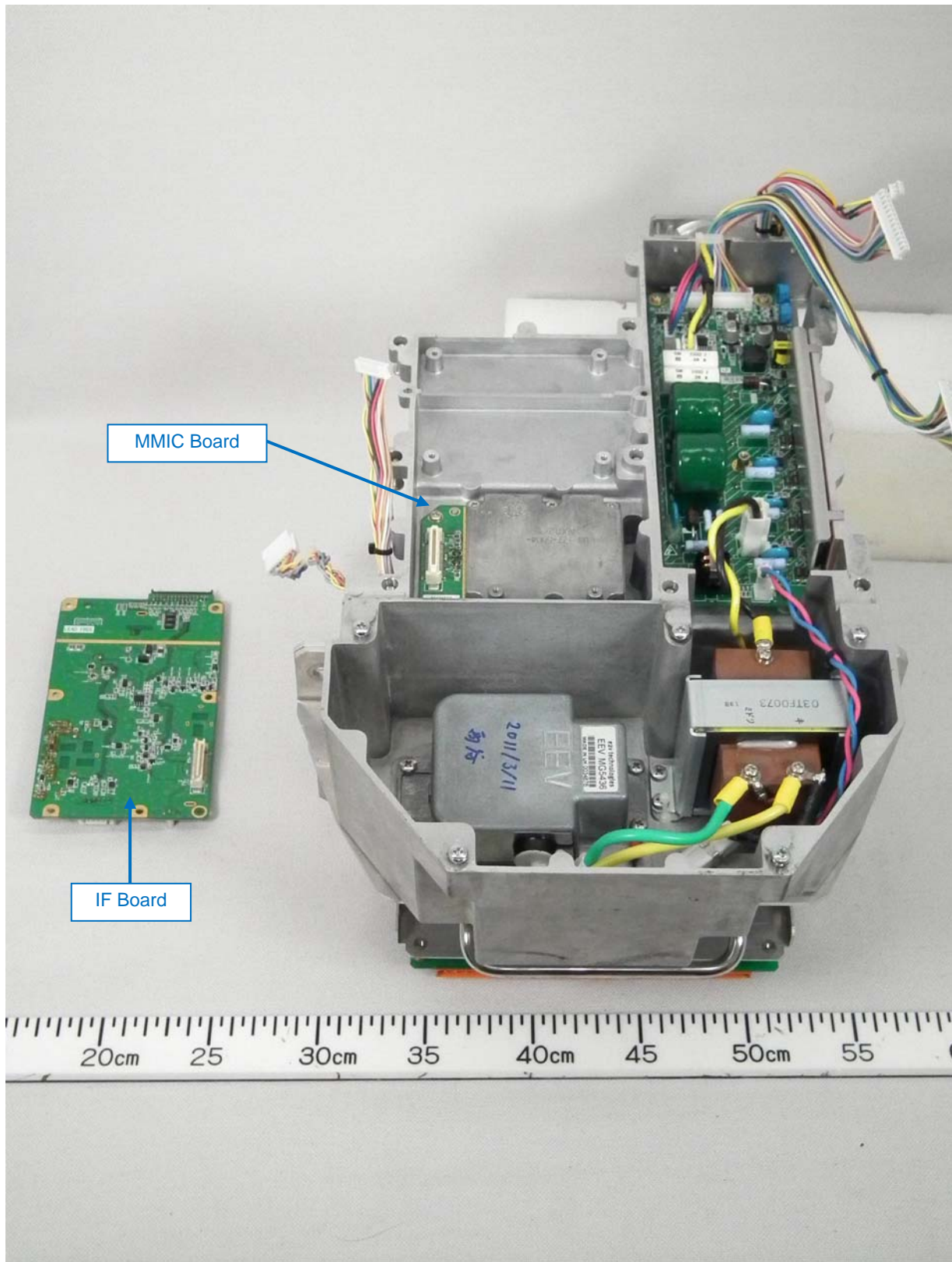

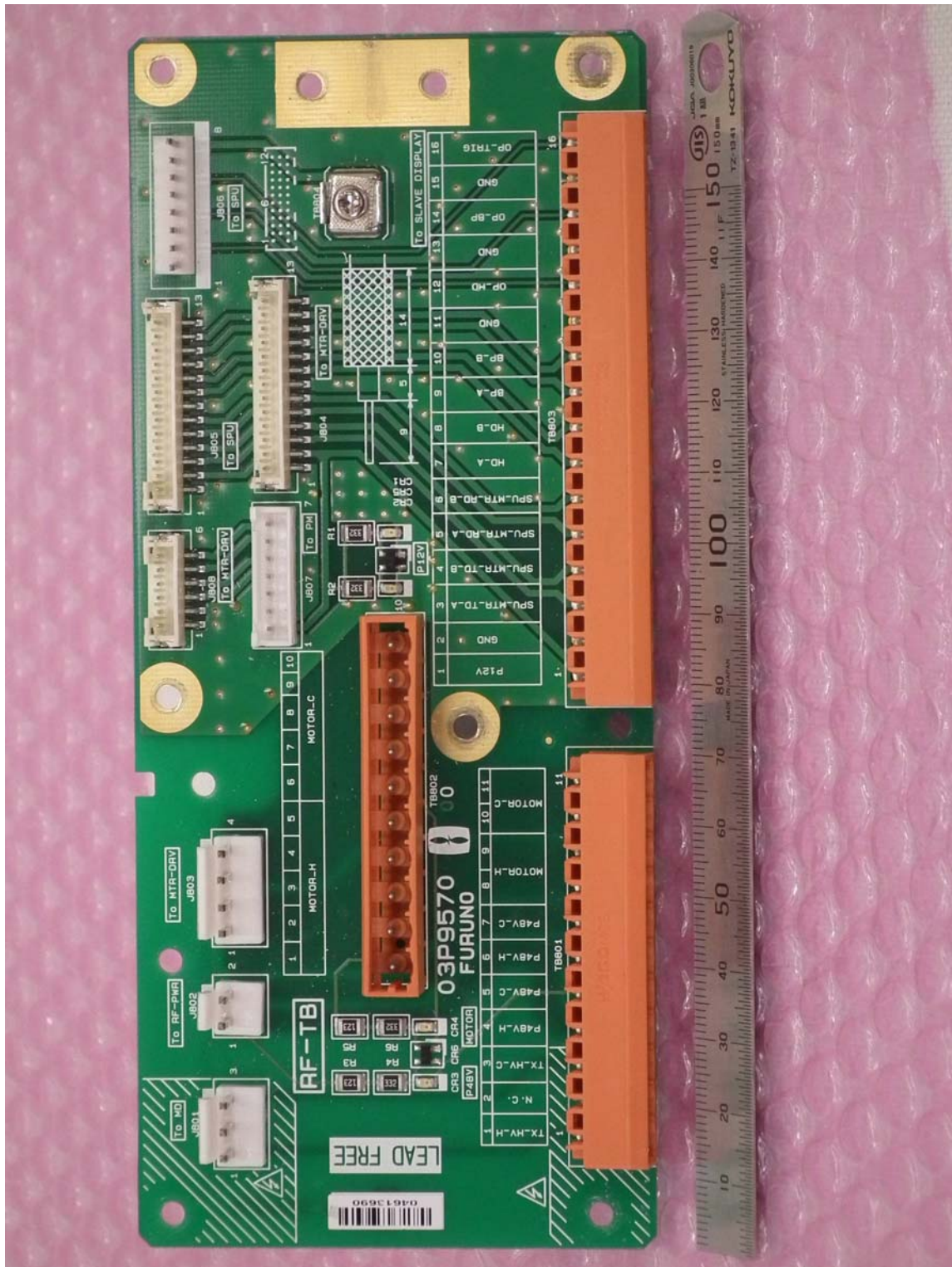


1.1.9 Bottom of Upper block (with IF Board removed, showing MMIC Board 03P9567)

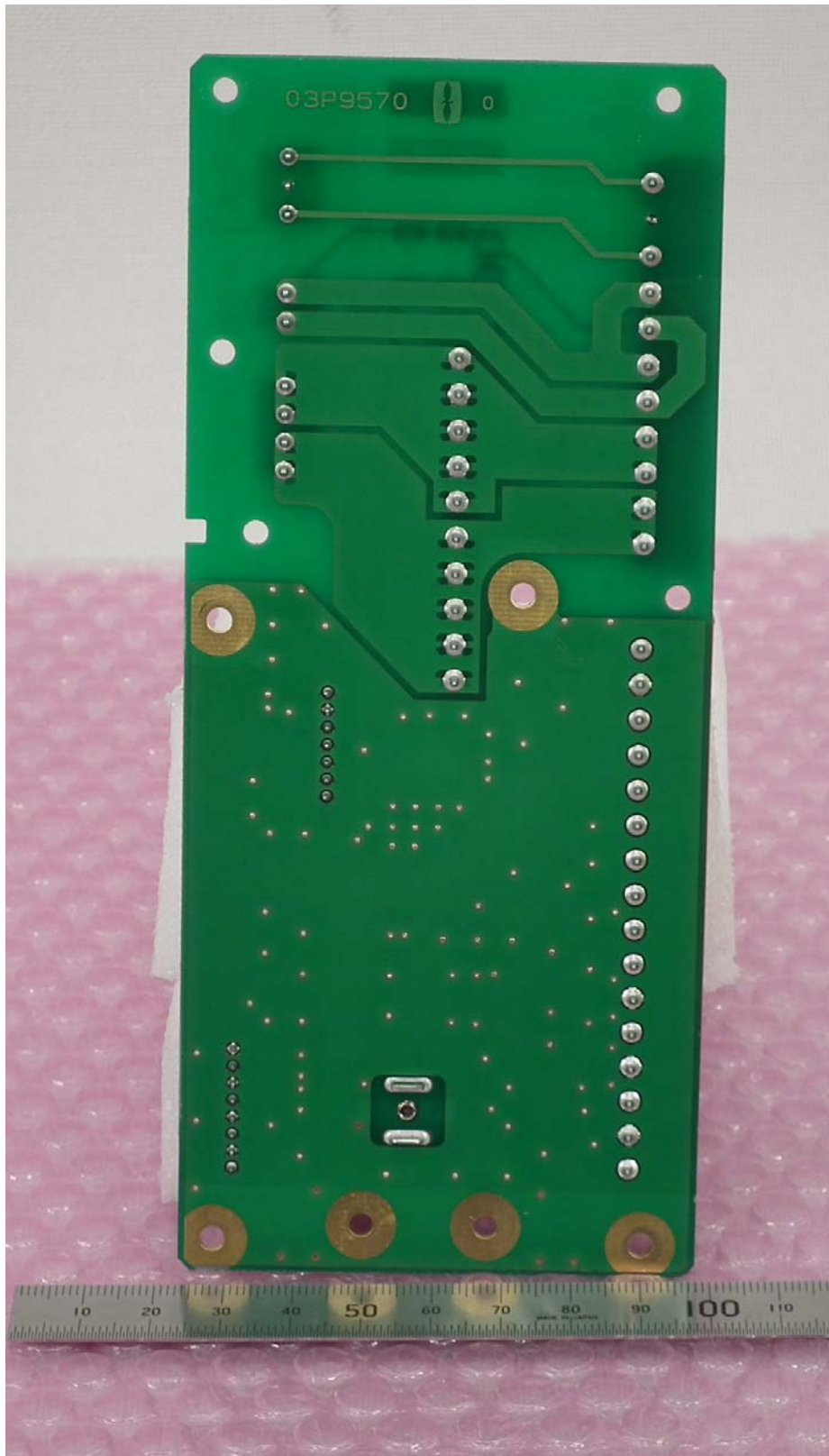

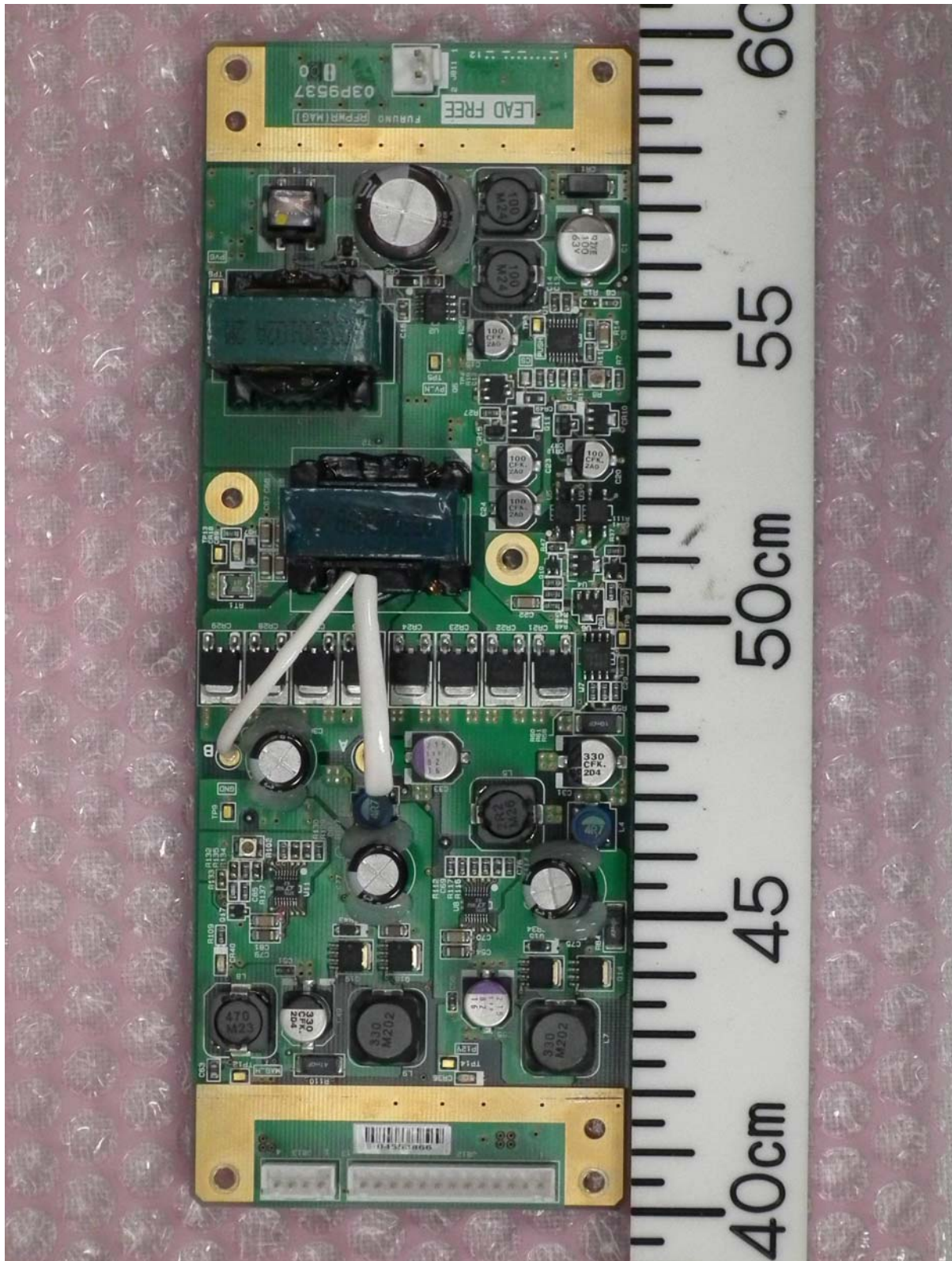

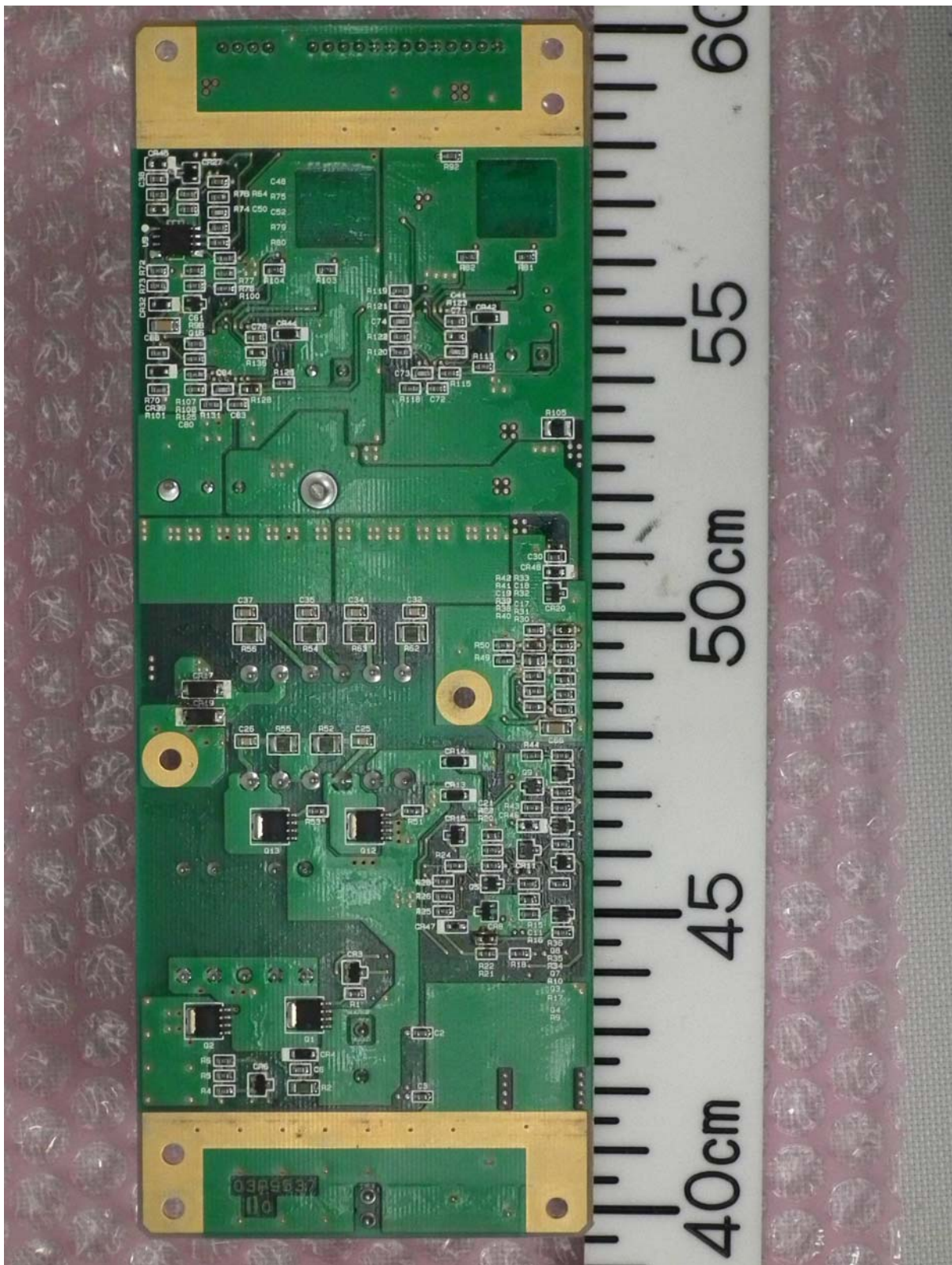

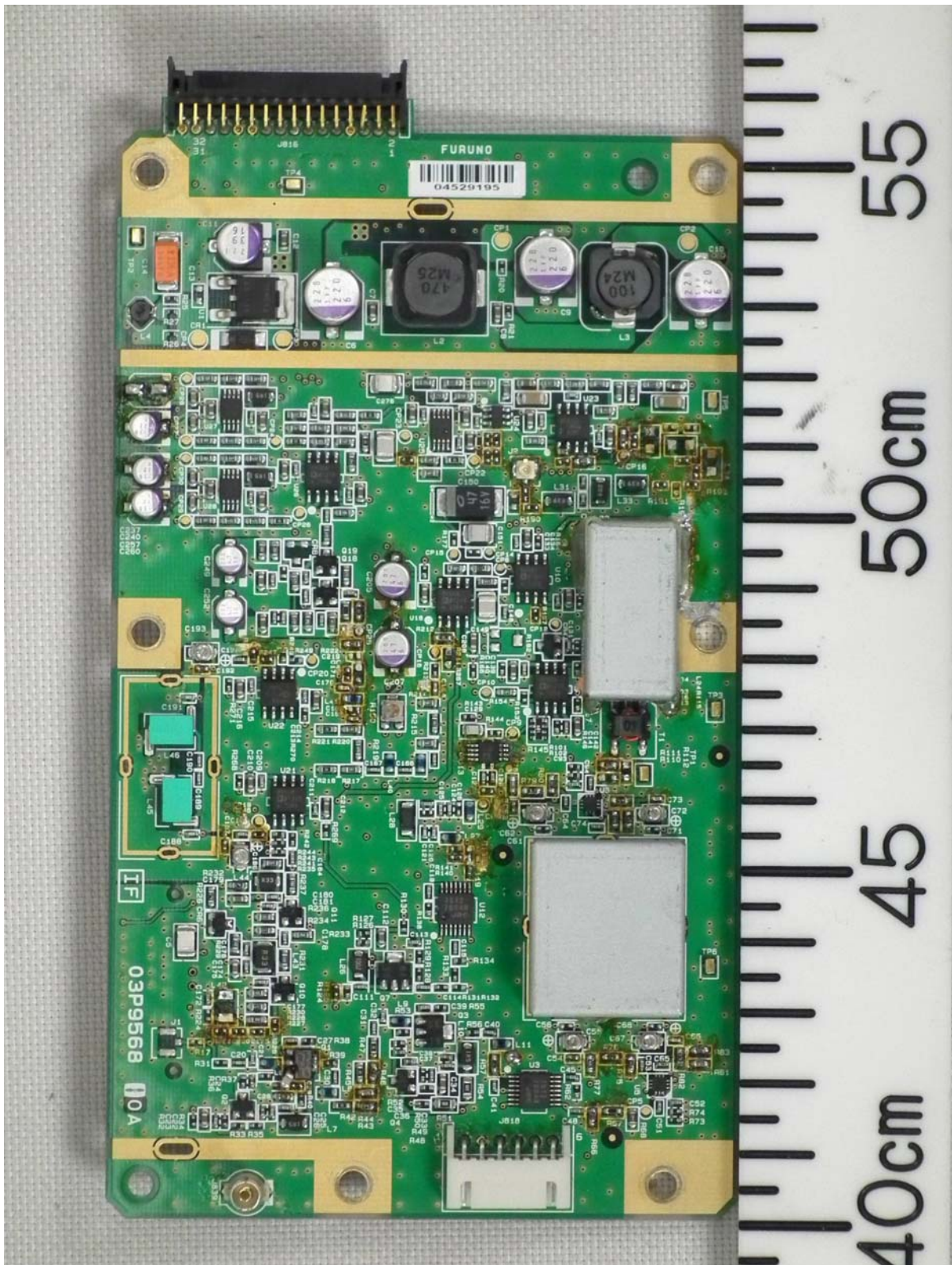

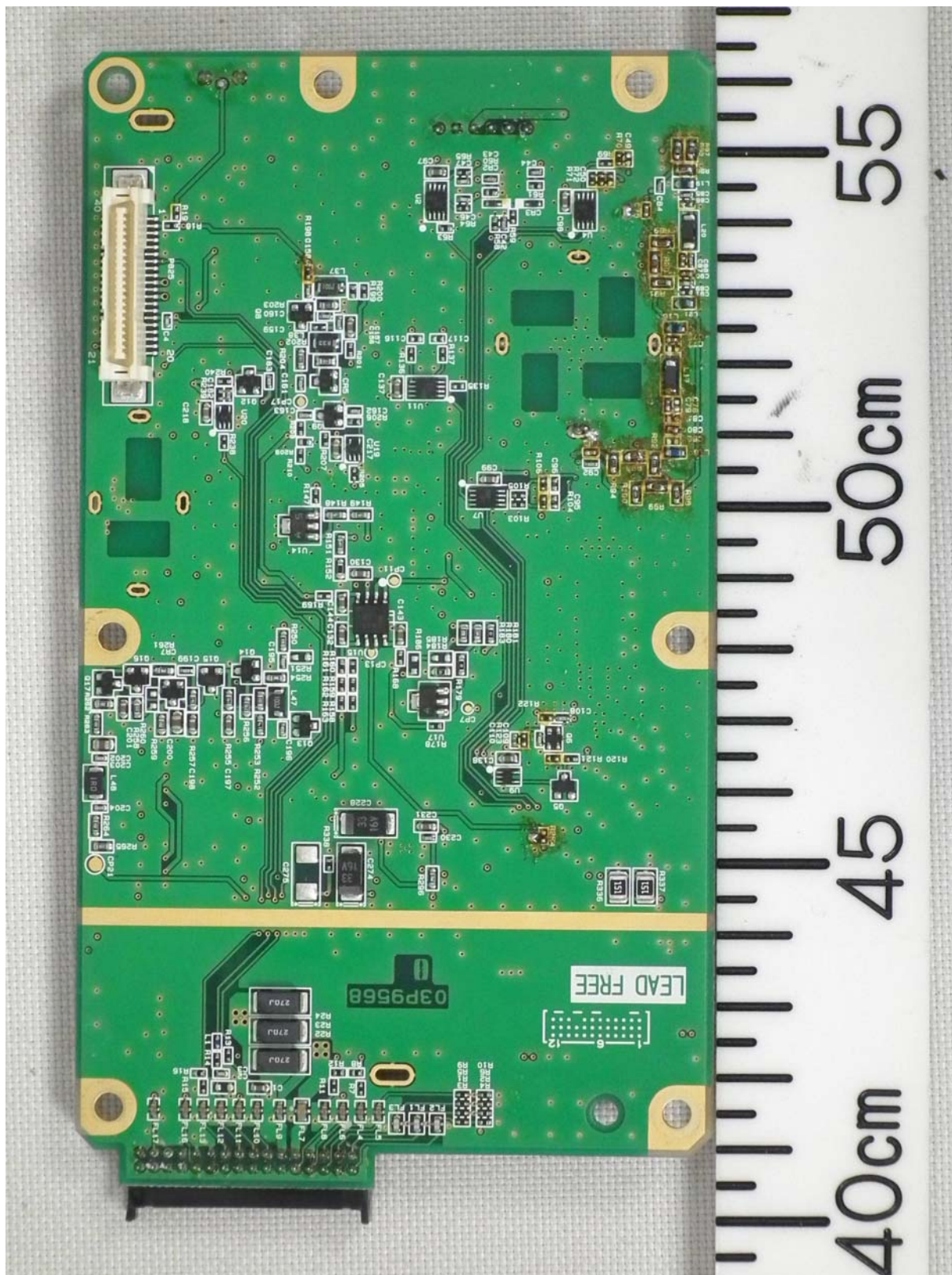

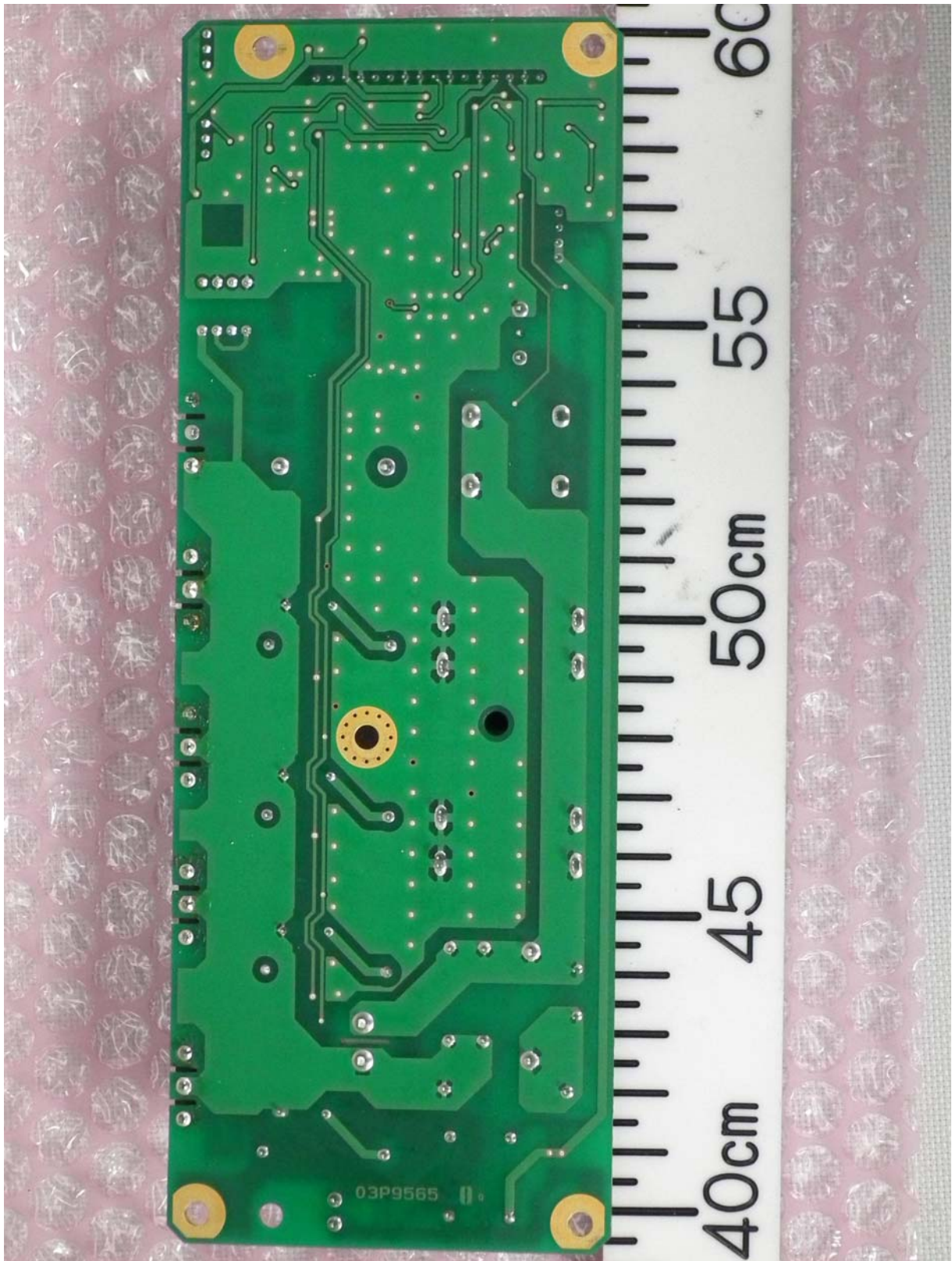

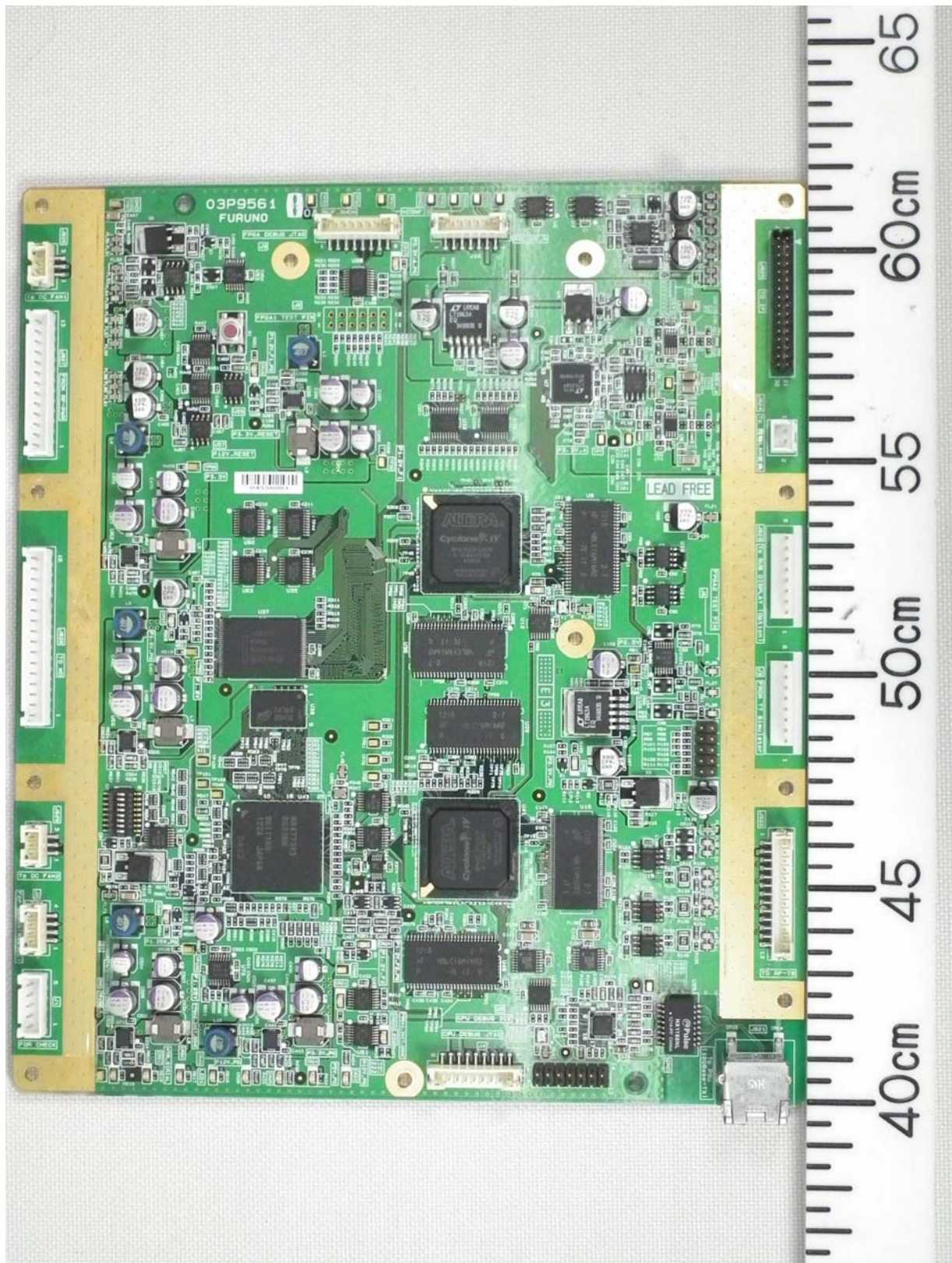

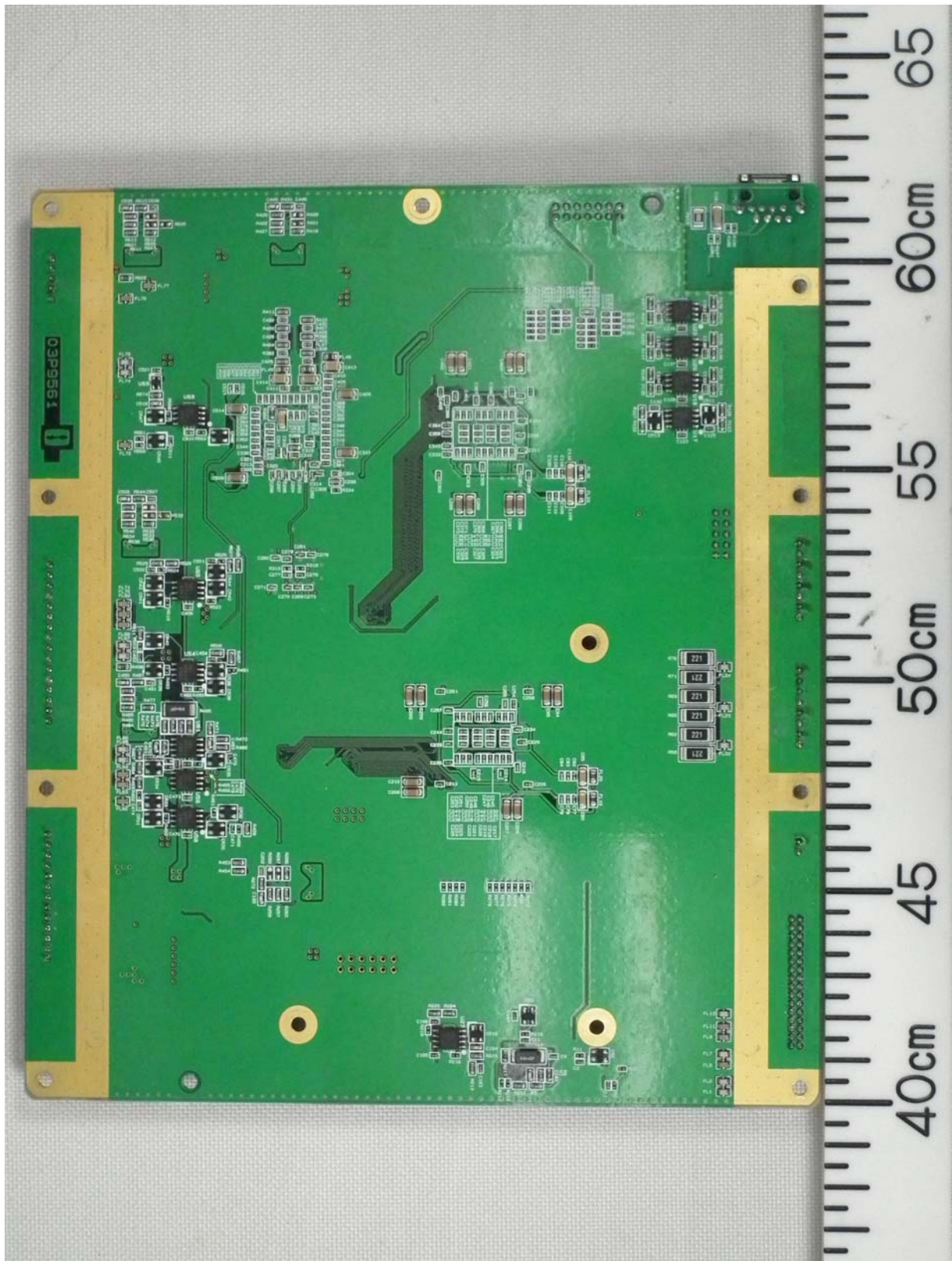

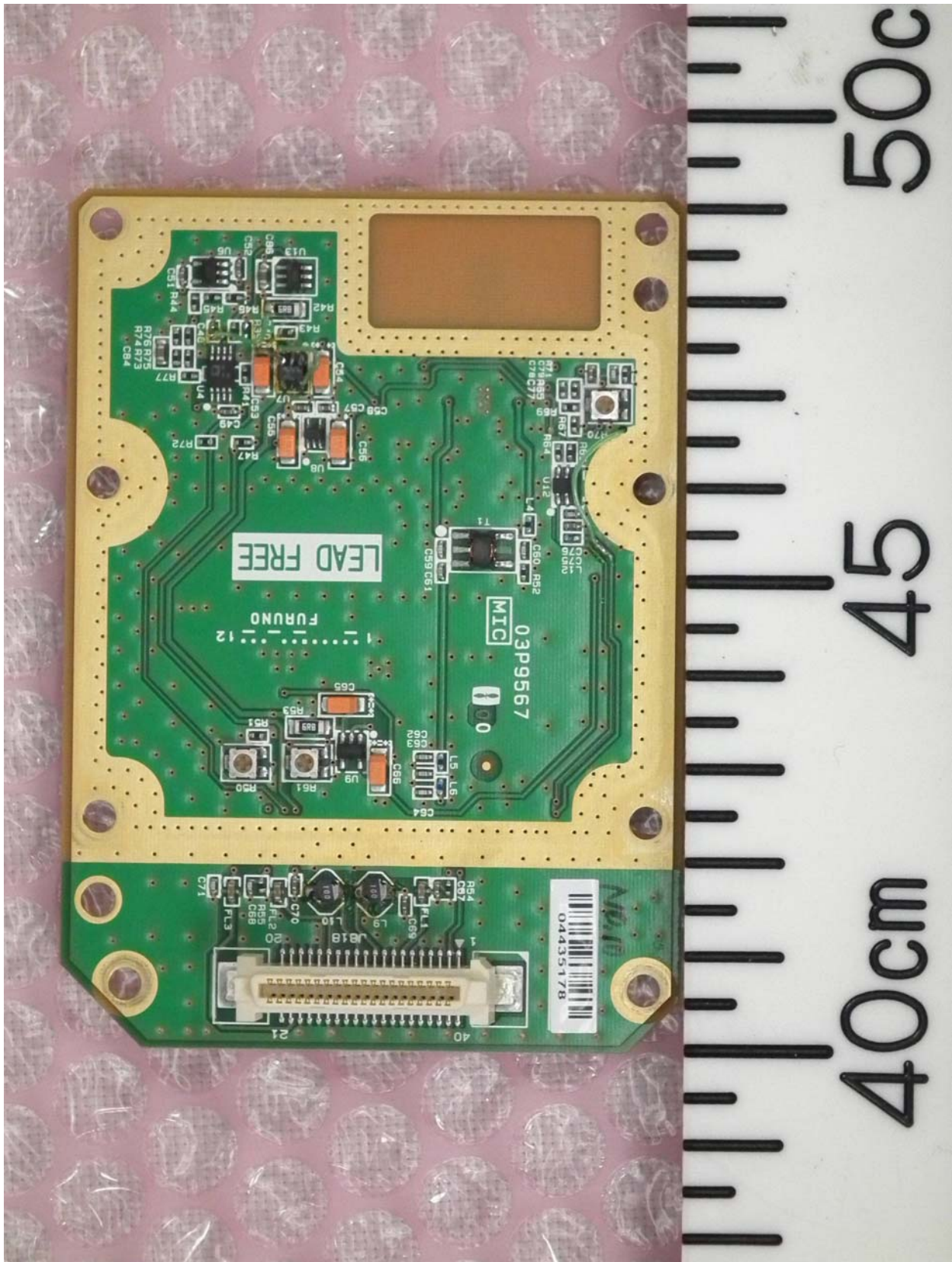
