(1) Attached please find the internal photos with the shield removed per your request.

(2) The equipment under test is a fixed base station with the antenna located outdoor on the top-roof or antenna tower. It is exempted from FCC RF Exposure requirement. Some FCC examiners do not want the RF Exposure statement in the users manual for fixed base station at all since it is not applicable by FCC Rules. In the past, FCC requested the our clients to remove the RF Exposure statement from the users manual for fixed base station when it was provided. I questioned them and they said it was only required for mobile (it is very weird since what is wrong if it is provided any way), I questioned different FCC examiners for 2nd opinions, and some said the same things but some said it was optional for fixed base station. In conclusion, it is not required for fixed base station. But if you still want to have it, we have to wait for at least one week for it to be corrected by the manufacturer in Japan. Can you certify without the MPE?
