I have a few comments on this Application.

1. FYI - Please note that on page 19 of the manual it states, "In order to ensure this distance is met, the installation of the antenna must be mounted at least 1 meter away from the nearest edge of the vehicle in order to protect against exposure to by standers." On the same page for the other model it states, "In order to ensure this distance is met, the installation of the antenna must be mounted at least 79 centimeters away from the nearest edge of the vehicle in order to protect against exposure to bystanders." However the drawing on page 13 clearly shows the antenna on the trunk area well within less than 79cm separation from possible persons or body contact.
2. On pages 1 and 5 of the internal photos there is a section of the board that is under a shielded cover. Please provide a photo or drawing of what is under the shielded cover.
3. Please note that the exhibit labeled "Plots19-27-TxCndt.PDF" are not plots but is a duplicate "icom49-f221-fcc90.PDF" file. Please provide plots 19-27.
