I have a few comments on this Application.

- Please note that ANSI C63.4 is specific to unlicensed part 15 devices and are not 'normative' reference documents for licensed devices. Use of ANSI C63.4 for licensed devices has no meaning and should not be used. For licensed devices TIA603-1 is the FCC accepted test methodology. Please explain why ANSI C63.4 is incorrectly referenced in section 2.1 of your report. Please test using TIA603-1 as applicable.
- 2. Please note that CISPR 22/ EN55022 are not 'normative' references for licensed devices. Please explain why they are referenced as such in the report.
- 3. Please note that TIA603-1 is the accepted FCC test method (as applicable) for all 47CFR licensed devices. Please explain why this document was not used or referenced in the report.
- 4. Please note that rf exposure must be provided in a separate exhibit. This is a requirement of the FCC in its uploading of exhibits. Please extract the MPE calculation section of your report and provide it as a separate exhibit.
- 5. Please provide an attestation that the G2B modulation implemented is in accordance to the appropriate ITU requirements.
- 6. Please note that it is customary to provide Occupied Bandwidth Plots. There does not appear to be OBW plots in the report. Please explain.
