The label shall be permanently affixed to the equipment and shall be readily visible to the purchaser at time of purchase. Label content and location are as shown in the accompanying application.

The Icom model **IC-T81A** is too small physically to support the **FCC ID#** on the back of the radio,


The only area available other than the battery pack is the area underneath the belt-clip where it would not be visible to the purchaser.

As a result, we would like to place the FCC identification number underneath the battery pack when the radio is in operation

The FCC ID number would be clearly visible to the user when the radio is purchased as the radio and battery pack will be separated and must be removed individually from the carton.
