Gentlemen:

Pursuant to our discussions with Mr. Bruce A. Romano, Associate Chief/Legal Counsel for the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) Office of Engineering and Technology (OET), we are submitting an Application for Equipment Authorization on FCC Form 731 using the OET's online filing system. This application, filed in accordance with FCC Part 2.933 (a), requests a change in the FCC identifier for a distance measuring receiver-transmitter, the DME-900. The original FCC identifier as granted by the FCC on September 28, 1994 is AJK9URPN822-0329. We are requesting that a new FCC identifier be granted for this equipment under identifier AJKPN822-0329. The new identifier eliminates the "9UR" Manufacturer Code that is not required under FCC regulations.

We are submitting a complete copy of the original filing documents from 1994 since we are informed by Mr. Ramono that the original filing is no longer available to the OET. The statement required under FCC Part 2.933(b) is also enclosed as Exhibit 1.

In accordance with FCC Part 87.147(d), a complete copy of this application is being forwarded to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). A copy to the transmittal letter to the FAA is enclosed as Exhibit 2.
