


OBees is a V 4.1 Bluetooth Sport Headphones supporting multipoint connection and voice prompts in Chinese, English, Spanish and French .



TURNING OBees ON/OFF

To turn OBees on:
Long press MF button for 3 seconds. The blue LED light flashes with a voice prompt. The headphones are now turned on.

To turn OBees off:
Long press MF button for 3 seconds. The red LED light flashes with a voice prompt. The headphones are now turned off.

You are required to pair OBees with your mobile phone before using it.

### PAIRING OBees WITH A MOBILE PHONE

1. Long press MF button for about 5 seconds until the blue LED light turns on with a voice prompt, and OBees is now in pairing mode

2. Activate Bluetooth function on your mobile phone.
3. Set your phone to discover OBees and operate following the instruction.
4. If password or PIN-code is required, confirm with 0000.

LANGUAGE SELECTING

OBees supports voice prompts in Chinese, English, Spanish and French. When OBees is on and not connected with other devices, double press the "V+" button to select the language you need and you can hear voice prompt. At this time, OBees has been switched to a different language.

CONNECTING WITH A PC OR PDA

You can connect OBees with a Bluetooth-enabled PC or PDA that supports headphones or hands free profiles. Please refer to the user manual of your Bluetooth-enabled PC or PDA for setup information.

FACTORY RESET

To restore the headset to factory setting, you will have to turn off the headphones first. And then long press the MF-button for 8 seconds. When the blue LED light is off, the factory reset is successful.
