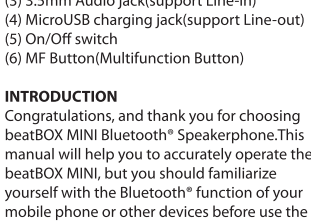

Jabees beatBOX MINI is a V4.1 Bluetooth® Waterproof Speakerphone supporting Multipoint & Voice prompt, as well as Line-in by 3.5mm jack & Line-out by MicroUSB jack.

INTRODUCTION

Congratulations, and thank you for choosing beatBOX MINI Bluetooth® Speakerphone. This manual will help you to accurately operate the beatBOX MINI, but you should familiarize yourself with the Bluetooth® function of your mobile phone or other devices before use the Bluetooth® Speakerphone beatBOX MINI.

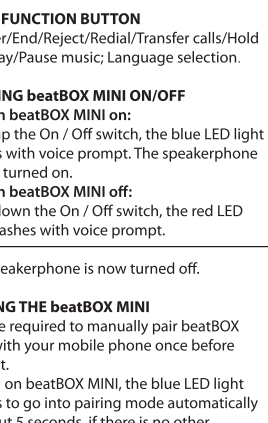
CHARGING THE beatBOX MINI

1. Plug the USB charging cable into beatBOX MINI.
2. Plug the other end of the USB charging cable into your computer or AC charger with USB port.
3. The red indicator on the speakerphone will be on.
4. When the battery is fully charged, the red LED light turns off then blue light turns on and accompanied by voice prompt.

WHEN THE BATTERY IS LOW

You can hear the voice prompt 'Battery low'. At this time, please charge the beatBOX MINI.

IMPORTANT

- For first time use, please charge beatBOX MINI fully before using.

- You must recharge beatBOX MINI if it has been not used for more than 12 months.
- You must use the authorized charger to charge beatBOX MINI.

MULTIFUNCTION BUTTON

Answer/End/Reject/Redial/Transfer calls/Hold call; Play/Pause music; Language selection.

TURNING beatBOX MINI ON/OFF

To turn beatBOX MINI on:

Slide up the On / Off switch, the blue LED light flashes with voice prompt. The speakerphone is now turned on.

To turn beatBOX MINI off:

Slide down the On / Off switch, the red LED light flashes with voice prompt.

The speakerphone is now turned off.

PAIRING THE beatBOX MINI

You are required to manually pair beatBOX MINI with your mobile phone once before using it.

1. Turn on beatBOX MINI, the blue LED light flashes to go into pairing mode automatically in about 5 seconds, if there is no other previously paired / connected devices in the range.
2. Activate Bluetooth on your mobile phone.
3. Set your phone to discover 'beatBOX MINI' and follow the instruction.
4. If your phone asks for passkey or PIN-code, confirm with '0000' (4 zero).

5. When the phone and beatBOX MINI are paired and connected, you will hear the voice prompt.

AUTOMATIC PAIRING MODE

If there is paired device in the range, you can turn on beatBOX MINI (simply switch on when the speaker is off) and it will go into pairing mode and connect with the paired devices automatically.

PAIRING beatBOX MINI WITH THE 2ND MOBILE PHONE

beatBOX MINI supports Multipoint Technology, which means that beatBOX MINI can be paired and connected with two Bluetooth-enabled mobile phone simultaneously.

1. Pair and connect beatBOX MINI with the first mobile phone. (Please refer to the 'PAIRING THE beatBOX MINI'.)
2. Turn off beatBOX MINI.
3. Turn off the Bluetooth function of the first mobile phone.
4. Turn on beatBOX MINI and it will go into pairing mode automatically around 5 seconds when there is not paired/connected devices in the range.
5. Pairing beatBOX MINI with the second mobile phone. Turn off beatBOX MINI once the connection completed.
6. Re-turn on beatBOX MINI, it will be connected automatically with two mobile phones and accompanied by red LED light flashes.

NOTE: When beatBOX MINI is connected with 2 mobile phones by Bluetooth, you can make phone call and enjoy music with these 2 mobile phones by turns as you like.

MAKING CALLS

1. Using voice dialing:
Once beatBOX MINI is successfully paired and connected with your mobile phone, you can use it to make and receive calls. beatBOX MINI can be used with voice dialing if your mobile phone supports this feature. Please consult your mobile phone's manual for more information.
2. Using the phone keys to make a call:
Enter and dial the number on the mobile

phone as you normally do. Once the call has been set up, the sound will be transmitted to beatBOX MINI automatically.

3. Redial:
Press and hold the MF Button for 2 seconds to redial the last number you called.

ANSWERING / ENDING / REJECTING CALLS

You will hear a musical tone or beep (This is subject to the mobile phone.) from beatBOX MINI when there is an incoming call, if beatBOX MINI is turned on and in connected mode.

- Press the MF Button once to answer the call.
- Press the MF Button once to end the call.
- Long press the MF Button for 2 seconds to reject the call.

CALLER ID READING

beatBOX MINI supports reading the caller's phone number when incoming call.

PUT THE CALL ON HOLD

In call wait state:

- Long press the MF Button for 2 seconds to put the current call on hold and accept the call waiting.
- Long press the MF Button for 2 seconds to resume to the first call.

TRANSFERRING CALLS

To transfer a call to the mobile phone and back: During both incoming call and outgoing call state, you can double-press the MF Button to transfer the call to the mobile phone. Vice versa.

PLAY AND PAUSE MUSIC

Short press the MF Button to play or pause the music.

LANGUAGE SELECTION

Double press the MF button to convert voice prompt language among Chinese, Spanish, French and English only when beatBOX MINI is not in call state.

beatBOX MINI SUPPORTS AUDIO LINE-IN

beatBOX MINI supports 3.5mm audio line-in with the Bluetooth and non-Bluetooth device to convert audio from the original audio output device to beatBOX MINI. When you want to use the audio line-in feature, please make sure beatBOX MINI is turned on.

NOTE: When beatBOX MINI is both connected by 3.5mm cable & Bluetooth, it will play the music of 3.5mm cable preferentially, while the Bluetooth function can still work normally.

beatBOX MINI SUPPORTS AUDIO LINE-OUT

beatBOX MINI supports MicroUSB jack (3.5 mm-USB audio cable) audio line-out with 1 or more Bluetooth and non-Bluetooth devices ,

when beatBOX MINI connect with the original audio output device by either Bluetooth or 3.5mm audio cable.

- ① Connect by 3.5mm cable
- ② Connect by Bluetooth
