Remote control does not work, or no disc

If the disc or not the disc is placed up side down or not, place the disc with the correct side down.
If the disc is dirty. Clean the disc.
If the disc is moisture inside, take off the disc and power off unit for about 10 minutes.
If the power cord and plug the power cord into the wall outlet correctly again to reset unit.

Remote control does not work properly

If there is an obstacle in the path of the remote control and this unit.
If there is an obstacle. Check if remote control point to receiver or not.
If the batteries in the remote control are exhausted. Replace the batteries with new ones.
If the remote control has poor contact with the dealer or approved service center help if the problem can't be solved by the methods offered.

Basic Operation

MP3 can be played by List mode, Program mode and normal mode Select one mode during stop. Press Repeat to play, repeat playing or play by list.

JPEG

Press Number Buttons to Select Pictures

Navigation Buttons

Navigation Buttons to make free selection in title, content and setup easily.
Navigation buttons on the player can perform Fast Forward/Fast Back, Previous/Next functions.

When program to enter into program menu, input the number of the title, the track or a song.
When the navigation button to select the track you want to start playing.
When the repeat program function, press Program to enter into program menu and repeat Program to cancel.

When the mute one or more to select mute on or mute off.

When the USB button continuously to select playing list between USB/SD/DVD and will be transmitted only through the built-in speaker when it is in input mode.

When the AU button continuously to select from AU/GAMES/DVD/TV mode. When there is no signals, the screen will be blue.

Their will be a vapor formation on convex mirror. To de-vaporize it please take out the disc and power ON the unit about one hour.
Please wipe the machine with soft and dry cloth dipped optional was liquor in case of scratching the screen.

Note

Handling discs:

Do not touch the playback side of the disc. Hold the disc by the edge that fingerprints will not get on the surface.
Do not stick paper or tape on the disc.

Storing discs:

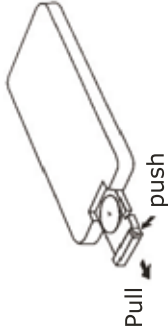
After playing, store the disc in its case.
Do not expose the disc to direct sunlight or sources of heat, or leave parked car exposed to direct sunlight, as there may be a considerable temperature increase inside the car.

Cleaning discs:

Fingerprints and dust on the disc can cause poor picture quality and distortion. Before playing, clean the disc with a clean cloth. Wipe the disc from the center out. Do not use strong solvents such as alcohol, benzine, thinner.

A-B

While playing DVD/VCD disc, press A-B for the first time to repeat one chapter,⌂A appear in screen, press A-B for the second time to playing A-B chapter,⌂AB appear in screen, press A-B for the third cancel

Zoom

In this mode, the dynamic or still picture can be zoomed in/out at 4 folds. Press Zoom for three times, the picture is zoomed in by 2X, 1/2, 1/3, 1/4 folds per order. And press Zoom again to return to the playing mode.

Repeat

(1) While playing DVD disc, press Repeat for the first time to repeat one chapter, press Repeat for the second time to repeat playing o press Repeat for the third time to repeat playing the entire disc, a Repeat to cancel.

(2)In PBC off mode:

While playing VCD disc, press Repeat for first time to repeat one Press Repeat for the second time to repeat the entire disc. Press Repeat for the third time to cancel.

Subtitle
While playing DVD disc with multi-subtitles, choose the desired subtitle, it will show on the screen.
If the subtitle is not available on the disc, the subtitle setting is valid only for the current disc. the subtitle setting can be changed from DVD setting menu.

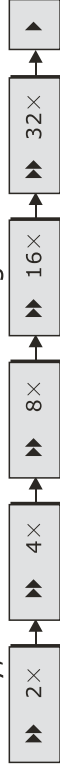
Multi-Language
While playing DVD disc is playing.
When playing discs with this function, you can select the desired voice by pressing Audio.
Left audio, right audio and the stereo shows on the screen while playing disc. You can select the desired one when playing story disc with dual languages.

This feature setting is valid only for the current disc which has multi-language settings.

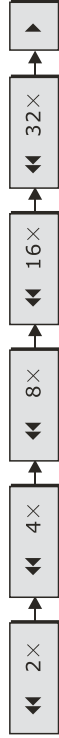
Functions Explanation

Fast Forward/Fast Backward (⏮ ⏭)

While DVD disc is playing, Press Fast Forward to play at 2X, 4X, 8X, 16X, 32X speed circularly, screen shows as following:



Press Fast Backward to play at 2X, 4X, 8X, 16X, 32X speed circularly, screen shows as following:



Press Play to shift to normal playing mode.

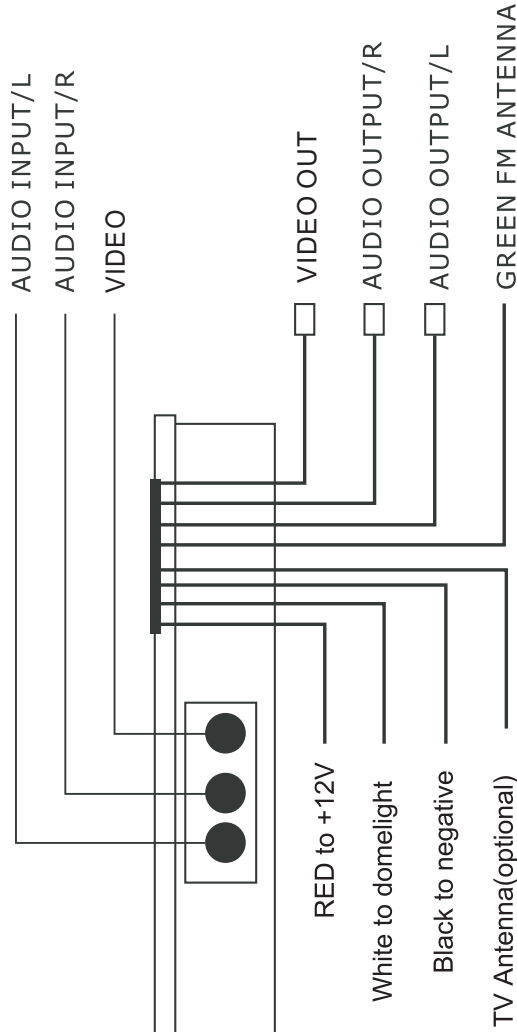
Previous/Next (⏮ ⏭)

To select previous item or chapter by pressing Previous button, next item or chapter, press Next button.

Note:

When a title on a disc has more than one chapter or a disc has more than one track, using chapter function can move to another desired chapter to play. If there is no Chapter/track on the disc, the above function is disabled automatically.

SECTION SKETCH METHOD



Menu/DVD

- (1) PressDVD Menu/PBC to return to the main menu or the Title menu while playing DVD disc.
- (2) While playing VCD disc, Press Menu/PBC to turn PBC on or off. (Unfunctional in DVD disc playing)
- (3) Only return to the main menu to select one song in PBC-on mode
- (4) Pressing Number buttons to select one song in PBC-off mode.

Title/Return

- (1) While playing DVD disc, press Title to enter into title menu directly select the desired item by pressing the Direction buttons or Number buttons.
- (2) While playing VCD2.0, press Title to return to previous menu; this function is disabled in PBC-off mode (Only for functional disc)

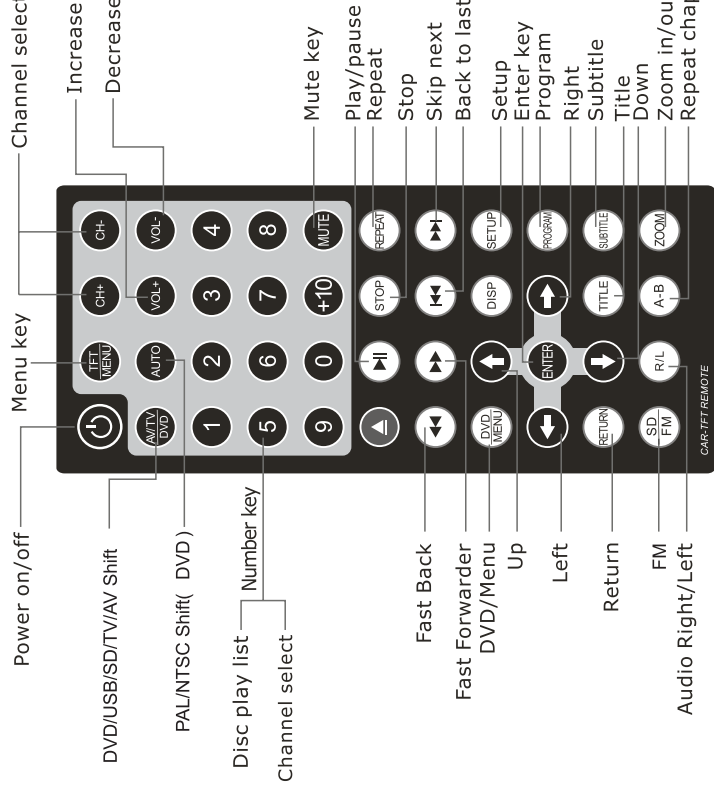

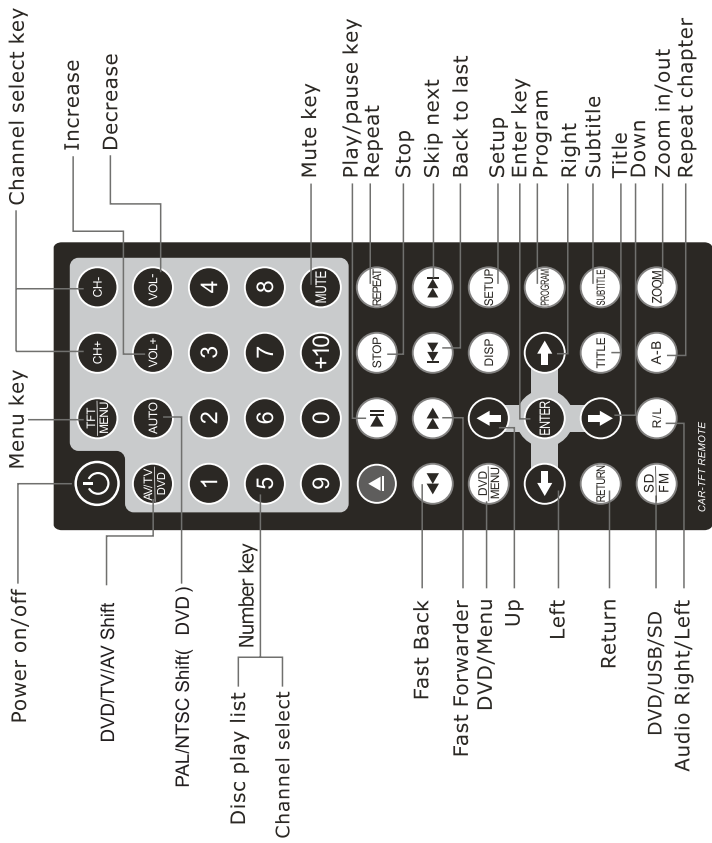
