
6dB BANDWIDTH (GFSK(4.0) MODE)




6dB BANDWIDTH (GFSK(5.2) MODE)

9.2.1 Measurement Procedure PK2:

Peak Power set:

- 1. Set the RBW = ≥ DTS bandwidth.
- Set the VBW ≥ [3 × RBW].
- 3. Set the span ≥ [1.5 × DTS bandwidth].
- 4. Detector = peak.
- 5. Sweep time = auto couple.
- 6.Trace mode = max hold.
- 7. Allow trace to fully stabilize.
- 8.Use the instrument's band/channel power measurement function with the band limits set equal to the DTS bandwidth edges (for some instruments, this may require a manual override to select the peak detector). If the instrument does not have a band power function, then sum the spectrum levels (in linear power units) at intervals equal to the RBW extending across the DTS channel bandwidth.

Average Power

Connect the EUT to power meter, set the center frequency of the power meter to the channel center frequency.

Average power set:

- 1.Measure the duty cycle D of the transmitter output signal
- 2. Set span to at least 1.5 times the OBW.
- 3. Set the RBW = ≥ DTS bandwidth
- Set VBW ≥ [3 × RBW].
- 5. Number of points in sweep \geq [2 × span / RBW]. (This gives bin-to-bin spacing \leq RBW / 2, so that narrowband signals are not lost between frequency bins.)
- 6.Manually set sweep time \geq [10 × (number of points in sweep) × (total ON/OFF period of the transmitted signal)].
- 7. Set detector = RMS (power averaging).
- 8. Perform a single sweep.
- 9. Compute power by integrating the spectrum across the OBW of the signal using the instrument's band power measurement function with band limits set equal to the OBW band edges. If the instrument does not have a band power function, then sum the spectrum levels (in power units) at intervals equal to the RBW extending across the entire OBW.
- 10. Add [10 log (1 / D)], where D is the duty cycle, to the measured power to compute the average power during the actual transmission times.


MAXIMUM PEAK OUTPUT POWER (GFSK(5.2) MODE)








MAXIMUM Average OUTPUT POWER (GFSK(4.0) MODE)






MAXIMUM Average OUTPUT POWER (GFSK(5.2) MODE)



TEST SETUP



TEST PROCEDURE

- 1. Place the EUT on the table and set it in transmitting mode.
- 2. Remove the antenna from the EUT and then connect a low loss RF cable from the antenna port to the spectrum analyzer.
- 3. The zero-span mode on a spectrum analyzer or EMI receiver if the response time and spacing between bins on the sweep are sufficient to permit accurate measurements of the on and off times of the transmitted signal. The diagram below shows the test setup that is utilized to make the measurements for emission from below 1GHz.








The diagram below shows the test setup that is utilized to make the measurements for emission above 1GHz.

9.7 POWERLINE CONDUCTED EMISSIONS

§ 15.207 (a) Except as shown in paragraph (b) and (c) this section, for an intentional radiator that is designed to be connected to the public utility (AC) power line, the radio frequency voltage that is conducted back onto the AC power line on any frequency or frequencies within the band 150 kHz to 30 MHz shall not exceed the limits in the following table, as measured using a 50 μH/50 ohms line impedance stabilization network (LISN). 




