


- Please read through this manual before making connections and operating this product. Retain this manual for future reference.
- Don't open the cabinet of this unit. No user-serviceable parts inside. Refer servicing to qualified personnel only.
- Switch off the unit when you don't use it. Switch off the unit and disconnectit from the AC power supply when it is not being used for a long time.
- Don't install the unit in a place exposed to heating sources or direct sunshine.
- Don't install the unit in a place exposed to moisture or rain.
- ●The apparatus shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing and any object filled with liquids, such as vases shall not be placed on it.

Connections

LINE IN/AUDIO IN

This unit have two audio input terminals. You can input the analogue stereo audio signals from extra devices such as VCD, CD, VCR,MP3 player, etc.

Use the audio cable(not included) to connect the input terminal **LINE IN/AUDIO IN(L,RINPUT)** on the top panel/on the rear panel of the unit, press [SOURCE] button to switch to the LINE IN /AUDIO INmode when the display screen on the the unit appear "LINE"/"AUDIO".

Bluetooth Connection

The bluetooth pairing mode of the unit is JBL PARTY XPERT, press [SOURCE] button on the top panel to switch to the corresponding signal source, the bluetooth icon(*) will be flashing quickly on the display screen, the party speaker is in searching bluetooth signal status, use your mobile phone to search the bluetooth signal of the unit, then input the password 0000 if necessary, the unit will synchronize to play songs on your mobile phone while the display "BT" on the display and the bluetooth icon(*) keep solid light on the display screen means to connect successfully.

Disconnect the bluetooth on the mobile phone to switch off the bluetooth connect.

The bluetooth is connected to your audio device successfully for the first time, power off the player then power on, the speaker will reconnected automatically press [PLAY/PAUSE] to resume the playback.

Note:

- •Bluetooth connection range in 10 meters.
- The model JBL PARTY XPERT in your device was not deleted.
- $\bullet \ \, \text{In blue tooth mode,} [\text{PLAY/PAUSE}], [\text{VOLUME}], [\text{MUTE}] \ \, \text{etc. are also active}.$

Connections

TWS Connection

- •This TWS(TRUE WIRELESS STEREO) bluetooth connection only use between the same two speakers.
- •Power on both speakers, press and hold TWS button on both speakers simultaneously, the both speakers will display ON-TWS on the display screen and press next/previous button to select between HOST and SLAVE, wait a few seconds to pair automatically, once connected successfully, the display HOST on the display of the speaker is configured as themaster, the other display SLAVE on the display of the speaker is configured as the slave.
- •Enable your bluetoothdevice and make sure it is in searching mode.
- •Select "JBL PARTY XPERT" from the list of discovered devices and connect to it.
- The master speaker will act as the left channel during TWS and will receive the bluetooth signal, the other speaker will act as the right channel to play music.
- Press and hold TWS button to disconnect the HOST and the SLAVE speaker connection in TWS connection mode.

PARTY CHAIN

Use an AUDIO RCA(not included) cable to connect the AUDIO L/ROUT sockets of this party speaker to another active speaker's AUDIO L/R IN sockets.

Basic Playback

TOP PANEL FUNCTION OPERATION



• Press to switch on/off the unit.



• Press repeatedly to select a signal source Bluetooth ,USB,RADIO FM ,LINE IN or AUDIO IN mode.



• Press to enter BASS ON sound effect mode, press it again to enter to BASS OFF mode.



Press to enterthe BT(bluetooth) mode.



•Press repeatedly to switch among in LEFT PARTY SPEAKER ,RIGHT PARTY SPEAKER and STEREO PARTY SPEAKER.

• Hold down to switch between TWS ON and TWS OFF.



• Press repeatedly to switch the different lighting mode of LED indicator light on the speaker (such asLED_1,LED_2,LED_3,LED_4,LED_5,LED_6 and OFF).

•Use the lightknob also to adjust the different lighting colour of LED indicator light on the speaker in LED 1 or LED 2 lighting mode.

• Press and hold to switch BLINK ON or BLINK OFF for the wall and floor flashlight function.



• Press to temporarily pause a playback; press it again to resume the playback.

• Hold down to disconnect bluetooth connection in bluetooth connection mode.



Press to skip to the next track.



Press to return to the previous track.



Press repeatedly to switch the different AUTO DJ sound mode among in DJ A1,DJ A2,DJ A3 and OFF.

Basic Playback

VOCAL	●Press to turn VOCAL effect ON or OFF.
EQ	● Press repeatedly to switch the different(BASS OFF mode only) equalizer mode SAMBA, POP, BALANCE, FUNK, ROCK, JAZZ.
DJ EFFECT	● Press to switch the diffecrent DJ effect mode and rotate the master volume knob to demonstrate the different DJ effect sound.
MASTER VOLUMEKNOB	•Use the master volume knob to adjust the volume value of the speaker.
MIC VOL	●The volume that is used for sing or making announcements can be adjusted via the microphone volume knob.
MIC ECHO	●The microphone echo volume that is used for sing or making announcements can be adjusted via the microphone echo volume knob.
GUITAR VOL	● The volume of your connected instrument can be controlled by guitar volume control knob on the top panel.
MIC SOCKET	•An external microphone can be connected via microphone socket stereo jack for sing or for making announcements.
GUITAR SOCKET	●The guitar socketon the top panel is used to connect an instrument.
USB A SLOT	●USB storage devices can be connected to the USBASLOT on the top panel for MP3 music
USB B SLOT	●The external devices can be connected to the USBB SLOT on the top panel for charging (Note: the USB B SLOT can not be used to play music only available for charging for external device. Output: 5Vdc / 2.1A

Basic Playback

USB DRIVE PLAYBACK

•Insert a USB drive into the USB slot on the top panel, press[SOURCE] button on the top panel to select USB mode and the unit will play start automatically the MP3 track in connected USB drive, if play does not start automatically, press [play/pause] button on the top panel . Capacity: 64GB. Format: FAT32.

MICROPHONE PLAYBACK

- Insert two microphones into the microphone socket on the top panel and adjust to a low level use the microphone volume knob on the top panel.
- Adjust the microphone volume and echolevel to your desired level use the microphone volume knob on the top

Now, enjoy the karaoke singing!

Tuner Operation

The following buttons are used in tuner mode. Press [SOURCE] repeatedly to select RADIO(FM) mode.

PLAY/PAUSE



- •Hold down to do auto scanning for the broadcasting radio channels, pressit again to stop auto scanning
- Press to switch between preset station and frequency.
- ▶▶I
- Press to skip to the next preset station when the display screen appear station in the tuner mode.
- Press to fine tune (increase) the frequency manually when the display screen appear frequency in the tuner mode.
- Press to skipto the previous preset station when the display screen appear station in the tuner mode.
 - Press to fine tune (decrease) the frequency manually when the display screen appear frequency in the tuner mode.

NOTE: In Tuner mode, [VOLUME+/-], etc buttons are also active.

Troubleshooting

Before resorting to maintenance service, please kindly check by yourself with the following chart.

Symptom	Cause(s)	Remedy
No Power	●The AC power cord is notconnected to the power supply or is notconnected to a power supply securely.	●Please check that the AC power cord is connected securely.
Sound There is no sound or the sound is distorted.		●Turn up the volume.
The buttons on the unit doesn't work.	●The unit is being interfered with static electricity etc.	Switch off and unplug the unit. Then connect the plug to the power supply and switch it on again.
