This is in reply to your referenced correspondence.

Item 1.

The original equipment report included data for power ranges from 25 Watts to 125 Watts. This was also stated in the original 731 form. Previous similar models had been approved for this power range (re. ATH2422004). For some reason, the 50 Watt grant was never discovered by E.F. Johnson until recently in preparing this Permissive Change. We request, based on previously submitted data, and the data associated with this Permissive Change that the 125 Watt rating be granted.

Item 2.

We concur that the condition of grant is "The antennas for this device must be fixed-mounted on outdoor permanent structures and RF exposure compliance must be addressed at the time of licensing, including co-location requirements of 1.1307(b)(3).

We trust that these answers are satisfactory.
