In response to the question from FCC regarding the de-rating guideline,

1. The material of the heat sink is aluminum.
2. The thickness of the inner heat sink is 2 mm.
The inner heat sink is screwed up to the one face of the cover.
The thickness of the outer cover is 3mm. This works also as a heatsink.
3. The total surface area of the heatsink is 170.33 cm²

In response to the question from FCC regarding the protection against out-of-band operation,

The only 40 channels no less no more authorized in 95.625 have been programmed in to the memory table of the microprocessor.

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
