This transmitter is primarily intended for use in a portable radio application with capabilities for conventional communications with a conducted transmit power which is adjustable from 2 Watts to 5 Watts.

This transmitter may be marketed to and used by employees for occupational operations, such as Federal and Public Safety agencies, e.g. police, fire and emergency medical, etc., per Rule Part 2.103 and other ITU regions per Rule Part 2.104. See KDB634817 D01.

The subject transmitter complies with CFR Title 47, Section 90.203, in that the operator cannot directly program the transmit frequencies using only the normally accessible external controls of the unit.

Please note that the CP185 complies with the RF Exposure limits CFR Title 47, Section 2.1093. The SAR Report was reviewed by the FCC Examiner at the OET.
