Please note that this equipment is marketed in the US for FCC and NTIA customers, Canada and other international countries where the band is still harmonized at 764 MHz. For example, Canada's RSS 119 list the 700 MHz band as 764-770 and 794-800 MHz. Please note that having the frequency starting at 764 MHz, also, aids in inter-operability with other NTIA customers. The FCC Grant note states "This Grant has extended frequencies as noted in the filing and Section 2.927(b) applies to this authorization".

In addition, a FCC License is required for users, including Public Safety Agencies, before they can operate on these frequencies.
