Accessing Regulatory Label

Procedure:

Swipe up the home screen, tap  **Settings** → **About Device** → **Regulatory Label**.

User manual (Section: Accessing Regulatory Label)

No any special accessories, access codes, or SIM card are required to go through the above steps.
