**Question:** You have asked for modular approval. You did not test the module in a stand alone configuration using an extender card. If you do not test in stand alone configuration then I can give you modular approval but only for the printer model it was tested in. If you take the module out and put it in another printer model you will need to retest the module inside that printer. That is why you test with extender card outside the printer. You then have an OEM module that only has to be tested for radiated test in other printers. Please re-test the EUT with extender card in stand alone configuration if you want to sell as OEM module or use in any of your printer models.

**Answer:** The client is expecting to have limited modular approval since the final installation limited to printers with the similar size. Therefore testing was performed accordingly by placing the unit within typical host. This part has been covered on the cover letter for limited modular approval.
