

2.5 EUT Operation Test Setup

The RF test items, utility "Tera Term 4.105" was installed in Notebook which was programmed in order to make the EUT get into the engineering modes to provide channel selection, power level, data rate and the application type and for continuous transmitting signals.



3 Test Result

3.1 Output Power Measurement

3.1.1 Limit of Output Power

For systems using digital modulation in the 2400-2483.5 MHz, the limit for output power is 30 dBm. If transmitting antenna with directional gain greater than 6 dBi is used, the peak output power from the intentional radiator shall be reduced below the above stated value by the amount in dB that the directional gain of the antenna exceeds 6 dBi. In case of point-to-point operation, the limit has to be reduced by 1 dB for every 3 dB that the directional gain of the antenna exceeds 6 dBi.



3.1.3 Test Procedures

- 1. For Peak Power, the testing follows ANSI C63.10 Section 11.9.1.3 PKPM1
- 2. For Average Power, the testing follows ANSI C63.10 Section 11.9.2.3.2 Method AVGPM-G
- 3. The RF output of EUT is connected to the power meter by RF cable and attenuator. The path loss is compensated to the results for each measurement.
- 4. Set the maximum power setting and enable the EUT to transmit continuously.
- 5. Measure the conducted output power and record the results in the test report.

3.2 Radiated Band Edges and Spurious Emission Measurement

3.2.1 Limit of Radiated band edge and Spurious Emission Measurement

In any 100 kHz bandwidth outside the intentional radiator frequency band, all harmonics/spurious must be at least 20 dB below the highest emission level within the authorized band. If the output power of this device is measured by spectrum analyzer, the attenuation under this paragraph shall be 30 dB instead of 20 dB. In addition, radiated emissions which fall in the restricted bands must also comply with the limits as below.

3.2.3 Test Procedures

- 1. The testing follows the ANSI C63.10 Section 11.12.1 Radiated emission measurements.
- 2. The EUT is arranged to its worst case and then tune the antenna tower (from 1 m to 4 m) and turntable (from 0 degree to 360 degrees) to find the maximum reading. A pre-amp and a high pass filter are used for the test in order to get better signal level.
- 3. The EUT is placed on a turntable with 0.8 meter for frequency below 1 GHz and 1.5 meter for frequency above 1 GHz respectively above ground.
- 4. The EUT is set 3 meters away from the receiving antenna, which is mounted on the top of a variable height antenna tower.
- 5. Corrected Reading: Antenna Factor + Cable Loss + Read Level Preamp Factor = Level
- 6. Radiated testing below 1 GHz is performed by adjusting the antenna tower from 1 m to 4 m and by rotating the turn table from 0 degree to 360 degrees to find the peak maximum hold reading. When there is no suspected emission found and the emission level is with at least 6 dB margin against QP limit line, the position is marked as "-".


- 7. Radiated testing above 1 GHz is performed by adjusting the antenna tower from 1 m to 4 m and by rotating the turn table from 0 degree to 360 degrees to find the peak maximum hold reading for scanning all frequencies. When there is no suspected emission found and the harmonic emission level is with at least 6 dB margin against average limit line, the position is marked as "-".
- 8. Use the following spectrum analyzer settings:
 - (1) Span shall wide enough to fully capture the emission being measured;
 - (2) Set RBW = 100 kHz for f < 1 GHz; VBW \ge RBW; Sweep = auto; Detector function = peak; Trace = max hold;
 - (3) Set RBW = 1 MHz, VBW= 3 MHz for $f \ge 1$ GHz for peak measurement.

For average measurement:

- VBW = 10 Hz, when duty cycle is no less than 98 percent.
- VBW ≥ 1/T, when duty cycle is less than 98 percent where T is the minimum transmission duration over which the transmitter is on and is transmitting at its maximum power control level for the tested mode of operation.



For radiated emissions below 30MHz






For radiated emissions from 30MHz to 1GHz




Spectrum Analyzer / Receiver

3.2.5 Test Results of Radiated Spurious Emissions (9kHz ~ 30MHz)

The low frequency, which starts from 9 kHz to 30 MHz, is pre-scanned and the result which is 20 dB lower than the limit line is not reported.

There is adequate comparison measurement of both open-field test site and alternative test site - semi-Anechoic chamber according to 414788 D01 Radiated Test Site v01r01, and the result comes out very similar.





WIFI 802.11g (Band Edge @ 3m)











WIFI 802.11n HT20 (Band Edge @ 3m)












WIFI 802.11g (Harmonic @ 3m)












Emission above 18GHz
