Model AT14A Operational Description

The model AT14A is a two-channel radio frequency wireless transmitter used to send music from an MP3 player to a wireless receiver. The wireless receiver connects to a stereo or any audio component that has an audio or AUX input. The device immediately transmits a frequency modulated signal when the user turn's the on-off switch to the on position. The device operates at 924.19 MHz with the channel switch set to channel one and operates at 924.89 MHz with the channel switch set to channel two.
