





AC Line Conducted Emissions - Front View


AC Line Conducted Emissions - Rear View






Peak Transmit Power Chain0 - Channel 0









Peak Transmit Power Chain0 - Channel 4

In-band emissions - Channel 4






In-band emissions - Channel 0



Out of band emission - 30-1915 MHz Channel 4








Out of band emission - 1930-1935 MHz Channel 4




