Hi Helen,

Below are the answers to your questions on the above application.

Question #1: On Form 731, the product name listed is 802.11b/g WLAN Dongle, the user manual shows a different name: HP Wireless 802.11 b/g Printer Adapter. The max. power output is 0.153W, which is subject to three host SAR evaluation if used in portable configuration.

Although the product name used in the manual suggests the product will be primarily used in mobile configuration, the name listed on Form 731 suggests the use in portable configuration. Essentially this device is just a normal WLAN USB Dongle, nothing else. Please explain whether the device can be used with a notebook PC, does the installation CD allow normal operation with a notebook PC? Please justify why three host SAR evaluation is not required.

<CCS ANSWER:> The customer states that this is meant to be a mobile configuration only. Please see attached declaration from the customer.

Question #2: The test report has an error probabl caused by pdf conversion. The section 5.2 lists MPE calculation, not Maximum power output. Please update the test report.
