











①	DISC Eject

## ■ Connecting Bluetooth

1		<p>After power is turned up, the screen says "Audio Off".</p>
2		<p>Press "MENU" of the remote controller.</p> 
3		<p>Turn the knob and select "Setup", then press the knob.</p> 
4		<p>Select "Bluetooth" and press the knob.</p> 

5		<p>After a cursor appears, press telephone button on the left, the screen moves to device registration page. Select and press the knob on the remote controller.</p> 
6		<p>It starts connecting to a mobile phone.</p>
