
Adjusting headset for your comfort



Headset is preset for use on right ear. Switch if necessary.




Bend to fit.




Adjust speaker volume (how others sound to you) on headset.

Charging your headset




Charge via desk stand or Charge directly (handy for travel).

Switch between two active calls	Press for 1 sec
End active call when another is on hold	Тар
