The Jabra JX10 (updated) Bluetooth headset is based on the Jabra JX10 Bluetooth headset with the following changes:

Antenna	No change
PCB	Layout change to accept component change.
RF component change	RX/TX filter change. Better insertion loss.
HW component change	On/off circuit and charger changed for low current consumption.
Battery	Change of PCM and capacity change from 90 to 125mA
SW	Major changes due to new platform implemented. Old Polo based on BL3.2. New Polo2 based BL3.5.2.  Polo2 improvements: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. BT2.0 with eSCO</li> <li>2. Hands-free 1.5</li> <li>3. Multipoint support i.e. support for 2 devices connected to HS.</li> <li>4. New MMI implemented in order to support multipoint.</li> </ol>
