Apple is requesting the following Items:

Removal of the Short Term Confidentiality treatment of those materials designated as "Short Term Confidentiality" for FCC ID: BCG-E2380A and FCC ID: BCG-E2380B as of June 23, 2010. This is in preparation of delivering devices to customers.

Upload the final version of the Product Information Guide. This Product Information Guide applies to both BCG-E2380A and FCC ID: BCG-E2380B. The preliminary version previously uploaded did not show the formal name of the product. This final version shows the formal name "iPhone 4". There were no other changes from the preliminary version.

Upload a corrected SAR report for FCC ID: BCG-E2380A. Following the initial submittal the SAR testing laboratory notified Apple that the original SAR report showed an incorrect reference to KDB 648474 for the simultaneous transmission calculation. In the updated report the KDB 648474 SAR-to-Peak location separation was applied correctly and the simultaneous transmission calculation continues to meet the FCC criteria  $<0.3$  resulting in simultaneous SAR not being required.
