- HAC Security document

This document reveals technical information that has not been publicly disclosed and that is protected by Apple as confidential and proprietary trade secrets. This information has only been disclosed to those required to maintain its confidentiality, and is not customarily disclosed to the public even after commercial release of a device incorporating or using such technical information. As a result, disclosure of this information by the Commission would harm Apple by giving competitors an unfair market advantage and could undermine the integrity of certain software security features in Apple devices.
