We, LG Electronics USA, hereby request for expedited dismissal of the above-referenced FCC ID on or before January 19, 2008.

The mass production of the LX400 model was unexpectedly delayed until March 30, 2008 and consequently the 180 days maximum hold of short-term confidential (STC) filed documents will expire on January 19, 2008. In order to prevent the premature release of the STC documents prior to product launch date and pursuant to the advised by the Commission's via email letter on January 3, 2008 (see attached), we therefore request the dismissal of the above-referenced FCC ID.

We also confirm that the above-referenced FCC ID has not been marketed or sold in the U.S.

The STC documents contain trade secrets and proprietary information not customarily released to the public prior to product launch. The premature public disclosure of these matters might be harmful to the Applicant and provide unjustified benefits to its competitors. Accordingly, we hereby request the Commission for dismissal of the above-referenced FCC ID.
