
# Using Stylus Pen

If you use a **Stylus Pen** for 16T90Q model, you can perform more precise touch control than when using fingers.

### Name of Each Part



### 1 Pen tip

• Performs the same function as a mouse cursor.

### 2 Left mouse button

• Use to select or execute programs.

### 3 Right mouse button

- · Performs the same function as a right mouse button.
- 4 Pen cap

## How to Use

The buttons on the **Stylus Pen** operate similarly to the mouse buttons and may function differently depending on programs.


## 🔘 TIP —

Applying excessive force when using the **Stylus Pen** may cause a failure of the pen or the **pen tip**.


The **Stylus Pen** automatically enters the sleep mode if the pen is not used for more than 10 minutes or the **pen tip** is pressed for more than 4 minutes.

To leave the standby mode, simply touch the screen with the **Stylus Pen** or click the left or right button on the pen.


1 Click: Touch a screen with the Stylus Pen once to use it as a left mouse click.



2 **Double Click:** Touch a screen with the **Stylus Pen** twice to use it as a double click.




3 Drag: Move the Stylus Pen while pressing the screen with it to use it as a mouse drag function.




## Drawing a Picture

You can draw a picture with a **Stylus Pen** using the **Paint** program, which is supplied with Windows 10, or a painting app that you purchased separately.

# 1 Click [ ] button > [Paint 3D] to execute the program.



2 Select a brush type and size in the **Paint** app and draw a picture freely just like drawing a picture with a pencil.



### Inserting and Replacing Batteries

1.5V batteries of an **AAAA** size is provided with the product. Insert the batteries before using the pen as follows

### 📶 TIP \_\_

If the battery level is low, the pen operation may be interrupted or the pen may not be recognized.

If the batteries have not been replaced for a long time, replace the batteries before using the pen.

AAAA-size batteries can be purchased through an on-line shopping mall.



If a battery of incorrect specifications or a rechargeable battery is used, the normal operation is not guaranteed.


If the pen is not used for a long period of time, store the pen after removing the batteries. Otherwise, the battery liquid may leak and cause a failure.

Do not apply excessive force when inserting the battery or detaching/attaching the **pen cap**. Otherwise, the product may be damaged.


If the pen is stored or moved with the **pen tip** pressed, it may cause the batteries to discharge quickly.

If you apply excessive shock to the pen or drop it, it may cause a failure.


To separate the **pen cap**, position the pen horizontally, hold the **pen cap** with your right hand, and 1 turn it downward



2 Insert the battery in the correct +/- direction, and turn the **pen cap** upward to close it.



 When replacing the battery, remove the existing battery and insert the new battery as shown above.




### Replacing the **Pen Tip**

A replacement **pen tip** is provided with the product. You can replace the **pen tip** using the method described below.



If the **pen tip** wears out, replace it.


1 Hold the **pen tip** with **tweezer** and pull it outward to remove it from the **Stylus Pen**.



2 Insert a replacement **pen tip** to the **Stylus Pen**.



If you push the **pen tip** with excessive force or insert it in the opposite direction, it may cause a failure.



# Connecting to External Display

## How to connect HDMI

HDMI is a multimedia interface that can integrate and transmit video and audio signals.

In some models, DTS Audio may not work when you use HDMI.

## 🔘 TIP —

Ensure the monitor power is off before connecting the external monitor to the PC. The HDMI cable may be connected when the HDMI adapter is used.

1 Connect the HDMI adapter to the USB-C<sup>™</sup> port on the PC.




2 Connect the HDMI cable to the PC and the external device (TV, monitor) that supports HDMI.

3 HDMI port transfers both video and audio simultaneously. Hence, there is no need for a separate audio connection.



4 On the PC, press [Fn] + [F7] to display monitor (projector) toggling screen. Select the desired screen output.

- If you do not set Speaker as the default value after disconnecting the HDMI cable, the system may not produce any sound.
- If a program was running already, you must exit and restart the program to produce sound.

# Connecting to Wireless Display

The wireless display feature connects the PC screen and sound to a display (TV, projector, etc.).

## 🌖 option -

- To use the wireless display feature, the display device must support this feature.
- To connect to the display device that does not support wireless display, you must separately purchase a wireless display connection device.
- Once the wireless display connection is established, no additional procedures and searching are necessary the next time you try to connect.

### Connecting to Wireless Display

1 Press the Action Center [ ] icon on the right side of the taskbar.





# Connecting an External USB-C<sup>™</sup> (Thunderbolt<sup>™</sup>) Device

The USB-C<sup>™</sup> port mounted on this product supports USB 4.0 Gen 3x2 standards. Use the USB-C<sup>™</sup> port to connect USB devices or to output a screen to an external display.

🚇 tip 🗕

The names of USB versions have changed from USB 3.0 (or USB 3.1 Gen 1) and USB 3.1 (or USB 3.1 Gen 2) to USB 3.2 Gen 1x1 and USB 3.2 Gen 2x1.

### Connecting a USB Device

💷 TIP —

If a USB device is connected to a USB-C<sup>™</sup> port, the port works as an ordinary USB port.

To use a conventional USB device, a separate conversion adapter should be used.

(Conversion adapters may be purchased separately.)

### Outputting to an External Display

By connecting a display that supports USB-C<sup>™</sup> Alternate Mode, you can use the USB-C<sup>™</sup> port to output a screen to an external display.

🐠 tip -

The Alternate mode allows you to use the DP (DisplayPort) and HDMI outputs through the USB-CTM port.

We support DP (DisplayPort) interface standards.



You must use a cable that supports Alternate Mode to output a screen to another display.

If you use USB-C<sup>™</sup> accessories (cables, interface adapters, etc.) that are used for other products, you may have compatibility problems (no screen output or a malfunction).

### Connecting a Thunderbolt™ Device





- 4 Use the Thunderbolt<sup>™</sup> cable to connect two notebook PCs.

# Using USB-C<sup>™</sup> (Thunderbolt<sup>™</sup>) Charging Function

You can connect the USB-C<sup>™</sup> device to charge a notebook PC battery or an external device, and the operation mode is automatically selected depending the charge settings of the connected device.

- To charge a notebook PC battery, the external device (USB PD Charger, notebook PC, etc.) should support USB Power Delivery 10 W (5 V / 2 A) or higher profile.
- The external devices that use the USB-C<sup>™</sup> port support 10 W (5 V / 2 A) and 15 W (5 V / 3 A).
- A USB device compatible with USB PD (Power Delivery) supports charging at 15 W (5 V / 3 A), whereas a regular USB device supports charging at 10 W (5 V / 2 A).
- USB PD batteries cannot be charged using the USB-C<sup>™</sup> port of the notebook PC.
- Always-On Charging is supported only with USB-C<sup>™</sup> ports, but not with the regular USB ports.
- If you connect an adapter with a lower output than the rated adapter, it may take more time to charge the notebook PC.
- 1 When the connected device is set to Automatic (charging the notebook PC or a connected device. Charging the notebook PC by using the mobile phone is not supported.)



2 When the connected device is set to Source (the notebook PC is charged.)

## 🔘 TIP –

The charging status of the external device being charged is not displayed on the notebook PC. If you connected a smartphone, you should select "Charge mobile phone" on the smartphone screen to charge the phone battery.

If the power consumption of the notebook PC is larger than the power supply from the external device, the battery may be consumed gradually.

# Bluetooth

Bluetooth allows the user to access wirelessly various devices such as camera, cell phone, headset, printer, and GPS receiver that support Bluetooth . It can also establish a network and exchange data with other Bluetooth -enabled PC or smartphone.



# Wireless LAN

The wireless network (Wireless LAN) is the network environment that connects a PC with the internet provider or company network through an Access Point (wireless or regular router).

## 🏉 option -

Wireless LAN is optional. Hence, it may not be installed in some models.

## Turning On/Off Airplane Mode

Prior to using the wireless LAN, press [Fn] + [F6] to turn off Airplane Mode.

Pressing [Fn] + [F6] keys will turn on or off the **Airplane Mode**. If you are not going to use the product for a while, keep the **Airplane Mode** turned on to reduce the battery power consumption.

## Using the Wireless LAN

If an Access Point (wired or wireless router) is in the vicinity of the PC, the wireless LAN can easily be accessed.

During the search for a wireless network (Wireless LAN), various Access Points may be found according to the location where the PC is used.







# Using a Wired/Wireless Router

A wireless / regular router connects several PCs and mobile devices to one internet line and enables the use of internet and the network.

A wireless / regular router has to be bought separately. Refer to the manual provided by the manufacturer for instructions.

### Connecting a Wireless or Regular Router

If one internet line is used with a wired / wireless router and several devices are connected, this may result in a slower connection.

In case of a wireless LAN, it is recommended to change the network name and security settings for a more secure connection.

### Network speed can differ according to operation environment and specifications.

- 1 Connect the internet cable of the modem that was provided by your internet provider to the router's WAN port.
- 2 Connect all devices (PC, IPTV, internet phone, etc.) with a LAN cable to LAN ports 1 to 4 of the router.

### The number of LAN ports can vary for each router model.

3 Please refer to the manual provided by the router manufacturer for setup of the network and internet.

# UFS/Micro SD Slot

This model supports UFS and Micro SD memory cards.

### Mounting and Using Memory Card

This product supports one UFS/Micro SD slot.

Make sure that the insertion direction of the memory card is correct and push it in until the **UFS** or **Micro SD** memory card is fully seated.



#### 🕼 TIP -

- When the memory card is formatted, the data stored in the memory card will be deleted. Check whether there are important data before formatting the memory stick.
- To format a memory card, right-click the memory card drive and select Format. When the Format window appears, press Start to continue.
- If the write protection tab of memory card is locked, the user cannot format the memory stick nor write or delete the data.
- UFS and Micro SD memory cards can be used only as data storage devices and do not support the copyright protection feature.

#### Removing Memory Card

Push the card with your finger to make the card spring out of the slot. Remove the memory card.



  - Optimal: This mode optimizes Performance, heating, and noise of the system.
  - **Performance:** This mode is suitable for CPU-intensive works. The mode may cause heating or fan noise and may shorten the battery usage time. It changes to **Optimal Mode** upon reboot.



When using for a long term, use **Optimal Mode**.

## System Settings Screen



- 1 **Screen:** Allows you to adjust the system brightness. (This function is not supported in a model that does not provide the brightness settings in Windows.)
- 2 **Sound:** Allows you to adjust the volume of the sound or use the mute function.
- 3 Touchpad: Allows you to set whether to use the touchpad.
- 4 **Instant Booting:** You can set the system to automatically boot whenever you open the notebook PC.
- 5 **Keyboard Backlight:** Allows you to configure the Keyboard backlight.
- 6 Touch Screen: Allows you to set whether to use the touch screen.
- 7 **External Display:** Allows you to configure the connection mode of an external display connected to the PC.

#### How to connect HDMI

HDMI is a multimedia interface that can integrate and transmit video and audio signals.

In some models, DTS Audio may not work when you use HDMI.

#### 🐠 tip —

Ensure the monitor power is off before connecting the external monitor to the PC. The HDMI cable may be connected when the HDMI adapter is used.

1 Connect the HDMI adapter to the USB-C<sup>™</sup> port on the PC.



# Using a Wired/Wireless Router

A wireless / regular router connects several PCs and mobile devices to one internet line and enables the use of internet and the network.

# A wireless / regular router has to be bought separately. Refer to the manual provided by the manufacturer for instructions.

#### Connecting a Wireless or Regular Router

If one internet line is used with a wired / wireless router and several devices are connected, this may result in a slower connection.

In case of a wireless LAN, it is recommended to change the network name and security settings for a more secure connection.

#### Network speed can differ according to operation environment and specifications.

- 1 Connect the internet cable of the modem that was provided by your internet provider to the router's WAN port.
- 2 Connect all devices (PC, IPTV, internet phone, etc.) with a LAN cable to LAN ports 1 to 4 of the router.

#### The number of LAN ports can vary for each router model.

**3** Please refer to the manual provided by the router manufacturer for setup of the network and internet.

# Wireless LAN

The wireless network (Wireless LAN) is the network environment that connects a PC with the internet provider or company network through an Access Point (wireless or regular router).

#### - Option -

Wireless LAN is optional. Hence, it may not be installed in some models.

#### Turning On/Off Airplane Mode

Prior to using the wireless LAN, press [Fn] + [F6] to turn off Airplane Mode.

Pressing [Fn] + [F6] keys will turn on or off the **Airplane Mode**. If you are not going to use the product for a while, keep the **Airplane Mode** turned on to reduce the battery power consumption.

#### Using the Wireless LAN

If an Access Point (wired or wireless router) is in the vicinity of the PC, the wireless LAN can easily be accessed.

During the search for a wireless network (Wireless LAN), various Access Points may be found according to the location where the PC is used.


