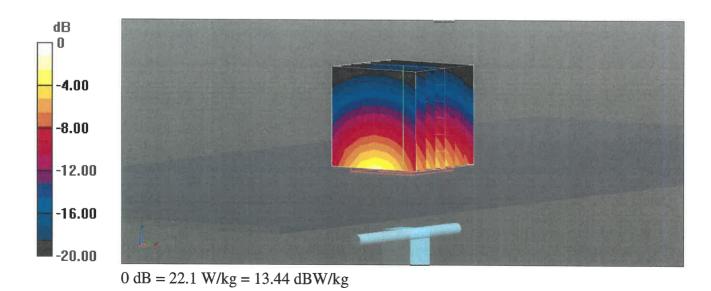

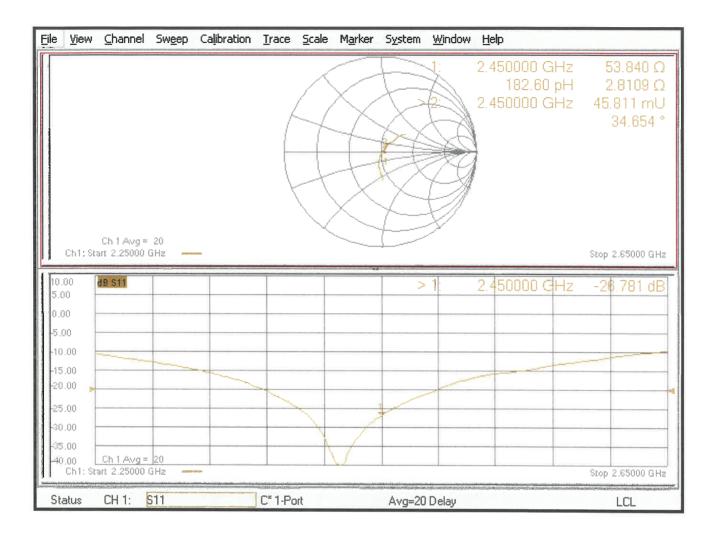



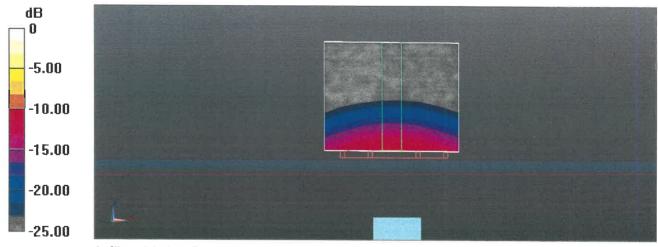



Plot for Antenna Parameters with Head Tissue 5200 MHz & 5300 MHz







Plot for Antenna Parameters with Head Tissue 5500,5600MHz




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Plot for Antenna Parameters with Head Tissue 5800 MHz







Plot for Antenna Parameters with Head Tissue 5200 MHz & 5300 MHz






Plot for Antenna Parameters with Head Tissue 5500,5600MHz
