I have a few comments on this Application.

1. FYI – Please note that this device appears to be a USB device (i.e. the pin out on page 2 of the schematics states USB). As such, it may be used in any USB port, including Laptops. This means that it is not a mobile device but a portable device. Thus MPE is not a correct method of rf exposure compliance.. Also, please note that this device is less than 1mW and thus would need only a statement in the manual that it meets the rf exposure requirements of OET65C. While you can keep the MPE report for information, you need to correct it to show portable not mobile (i.e. remove the 20 cm statement from the MPE report. Alternately, if this is not a USB bluetooth device, please explain the connector type (what makes the unit special and specific to the printer?)
2. Please provide separate setup photos. Please insure that these separate test setup photos are clear and legible.
3. Please note that the data plots in the report are not legible. Please provide a report where the resolution bandwidth, video bandwidth, center frequency and span settings can be clearly identified on the plots. Please note this applies to all plots in the report.
