I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- 1.) There appears to be some confusion as to the frequencies desired on Form 731. Please review your Application form and correct any exhibits as necessary.
- 2.) Is simultaneous transmission possible in both the 802.11b/g and 802.11a bands? If so, then the MPE exhibit should consider the effects of simultaneous transmission.
- 3.) There appears to be conflicting information as to if this device will be able to transmit outside the permitted frequency bands within North America. Please clarify.
- 4.) The label is wrong. We need labeling that is applied to this specific product. The label provided claims "Contains Inside". This is appropriate for the devices which receive a separately approved module – not the module itself.
- 5.) There is also conflicting information about the modular approval letter. The Manual clearly states that this device will be used in conjunction with Epson EMP series projectors. Please review. Choose if you want an LMA or full Modular approval.
- 6.) Please review your Test Report. The band edge emissions test does not appear to conform to the FCC guidance procedures for measurement of DSSS devices. Please review.
