




- . Wipe the battery dry cloth and set properly confirming ends(+,-).

Switch the sound output either ON or OFF.

- 1) It is used to select the channel you want to watch on either upward or downward direction.
- 2) It makes the cursor to move while in main MENU.

6. F. CH But t on

Watch your favorite channels.

7. I NFO But t on

Check the current program information, screen status, multi sound status and time.

8. EPG But t on

Press to view the DTV program information.

9. A/ D But t on

Press to add or delete a channel to form your channel list.

10. Power But t on

Turns the TV the TV on and OFF.

Power when On duing, the time is delayed, and "ATSC Booting" is displayed.
