




#### Location of Controls



- 1. [ I◄ VOL-] button: Previous track (quickpress) Decrease volume (hold)
- 2. [ ►► VOL+] button: Next track (quickpress) Increase volume (hold)
- 3. [ 🖒 ] **button**: Power ON/OFF
- 4. Indicator light
- 5. [ PLAY/PAUSE ] button: Play/Pause music
- 6. [ Connect ] button: Connect to Bluetooth
- 7. Audio socket
- 8. Mini USB charging port

### **Charging the Bluetooth Speaker**

- 1. Connect the small end of the USB charging cord into the Mini USB charging port on the back of the
- 2. Connect the other end of the USB cable to your computer's USB port.
- 3. The indicator light on the front of the speaker lights up RED when charging.
- I. The indicator light on the front of the speaker turns off when finished charging.




# Pairing the speaker with a Bluetooth enabled device

- 1. Turn the speaker on by pressing the [  $\circlearrowleft$  ] **Power ON/OFF** button. If you're using the speaker for the first time, press and hold the [  $\circlearrowleft$  ] **Power ON/OFF** button to turn the system on. After 4 seconds the audible signal is emitted.
- 2. The Indicator light will flash BLUE twice, followed followed by a RED flash.
- B. Press the [ **Connect** ] button. The Indicator light will flash BLUE and RED.
- 4. Keep the speaker and Bluetooth enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing
- 5. Set your mobile phone or other Bluetooth enabled device to search for Bluetooth devices.




On an iPhone Go to SETTINGS > GENERAL > BLUETOOTH (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)




#### On a Blackberry


• Go to SETTINGS/OPTIONS > BLUETOOTH Enable BLUETOOTH

On other Cell Phones/Devices • Review the instruction manual that came with your phone/device.



- 6. When the Bluetooth enabled device finds the speaker, select SBT602 from the list of found
- 7. If required, enter the password 0000. Select OK or Yes to pair the two units.
- 8. After a successful registration, the LED Indicator light will flash BLUE.

**Note:** If the speaker has already been connected to the Bluetooth device/phone, press the Power button on the speaker for 4 seconds to turn on the speaker again. The speaker will reconnect with the

### **Using your Bluetooth Speaker**

#### Powering ON/OFF

- To turn **ON**, press and hold the [ (b) ] button for 4
- •To turn **OFF**, press and hold the [  $\bigcirc$  ] button for 3 seconds.

#### Adjusting the volume

Press and hold the [ → VOL+] button to increase the volume and the [I≪VOL-] button to decrease it to your desired level.



#### Answering / Ending a call

Use the native controls on your mobile phone to answer and end a call.

#### To make a call


Dial the number and press the send button on your mobile phone. The call is automatically transferred to the speaker.







The speaker will read out the phone number of any incoming calls while connected to a Bluetooth enabled device.



#### **Cable Connection**

To listen to music using a wired connection, connect your music device to the audio port using the included audio cable.

**NOTE:** The Audio port does not work as a headphone jack. Whenever you connect the audio cable, the status indicator will light up BLUE. The functions on the speaker will not work with the cable connected.

## **Playing Music**

To enjoy wireless music on your Bluetooth Speaker, make sure you are connected to a Bluetooth enabled device. Once connected you can press PLAY on your Bluetooth device or you can press the [►|| ] button on the SBT602 Bluetooth Speaker.

Once playback has begun, you can control the music or answer phone calls from the control buttons of the Bluetooth speaker (with devices that have the AVRCP Bluetooth profile).

### Play / Pause

Press the [PLAY/PAUSE] button to pause the music. To resume music playback, press the [ PLAY/PAUSE ] button again.

#### Adjusting the volume

Press and hold the [►►] VOL+] button to increase the volume and the [I◀VOL-] button to decrease it to your desired level.



#### **Skipping Songs**

## (With devices that have AVRCP Bluetooth profile)

Quickpress the [►► | VOL+] button to go to the next song Quickpress the [I◄ VOL-] button to go to the previous song.

#### **Receiving calls**

When receiving a call, the music will stop playing automatically. You can transfer the call from the speaker to your phone, or you can power off the speaker for a private conversation. Once the call has ended, use your mobile phone to continue music playback.

### Troubleshooting Tips

- 1. Make sure your Bluetooth device supports A2DP profile. 2. Turn up the volume on your Bluetooth device.
- 3. You may have to unpair the speaker, then re-pair to your

- 2. Press and hold the [ 🖒 ] button. The LED indicator light on the front of the speaker will flash RED and BLUE alternately.
- 3. The speaker is now in pairing mode

- process. 3. Press and hold the [  $\bigcirc$  ] button. The LED indicator light on the front of the speaker will flash RED and BLUE alternately.
- 4. Check that YOUR device's Bluetooth feature is turned ON. 5. Try repeating the pairing process, see "Pairing the Speaker
- with a Bluetooth enabled device".
